Finding the controls



Liquid crystal display

- **2 Function** button initiates programming. **Set** button stores a parameter.
- 3 Phonebook button
- 4 Redial button redials the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.
- Flash button (For call waiting service users.)
 Erase button
- Auto Answer button & indicator
 —light on: answering device activated.
 —light off: used as a regular telephone.
- **7 Playback** button plays back recorded messages.

Record button records a telephone conversation.

- To record a telephone conversation ^{再生/通話録音} (Playback/Record) → # (Cancel the precaution voice message)
- To stop recording, press ⊖(stop)
- 8 Fax button starts faxing.
- **9** Copy button starts copying.
- 10 Stop button
- 11 One-touch Dial buttons
- 12 Block button for the undesired call

13 Secure button

While the unit is ringing, press this button. The unit announces a message to the caller. The message is announced in Japanese and means "This unit is currently set to Caller Verifying mode. Could you please speak out your name?".

- To talk to the caller, lift the handset.
- To hang up, press 🛞.

- Enhanced Record button records the previous 1 minute of the current telephone conversation.
 - To record the previous 1 minute of telephone conversation, press 耐い語 (Enhanced record).
 - To stop recording, press (stop)
- Volume buttons adjust the volume.
 Resolution buttons select the resolution when faxing or copying.
 Search buttons
- **16 Tone** button switches to tone dialing.
- 17 Sharp button
- 18 Intercom button
- 19 Monitor button
- 20 Hold button
 - Call/Fax List button starts a search in
 - the Number Display (Caller ID) log.
 - the fax list stored in memory.
 - Call/Fax List indicator lights when
 - a call was missed.(For Number Display service users.)
 - a fax was stored in memory.

Portable handset (KX-FKN526)



Installations and connections

Open the control panel. **2** Open the back cover. 3 Insert the ink film. Insert the orange gear into the left slot of the main unit. Insert the white gear into the right slot of the main unit. **4** If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding this gear (orange). 5 Close the back cover pressing " $\circ \circ \circ$ " down on both sides until it clicks into place. 6 Close the control panel. • When the unit runs out of ink film, the following message will be displayed.

Installing the ink film

Install a new ink film.

Installing recording paper (A4 size)



Folding the recording paper tray

 Remove the recording paper and fold the recording paper stands in.



(2) Close the recording paper tray.



Connecting the main unit



■ To adjust the date and time

- **1.** Press ^{機能/決定} (Function/Set).
- **2.** Press (#) (0) (1), then press $\overset{\#/k}{\bigcirc}$ (Function/Set).
- 3. Enter the correct year/month/day/hour/minute.
- **4.** Press $\overset{\# \mathbb{R}/k\mathbb{R}}{\bigcirc}$ (Function/Set), then press $\overset{\mathsf{Zhy7}}{\bigcirc}$ (Stop).

Installations and connections

Setting up the portable handset (KX-FKN526)



Press 🕞 on the battery cover and slide the cover.

2 Insert the battery into the compartment and close the battery cover.



Connect the charger to the power outlet, then place the portable handset on the charger for about
10 hours.



• After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, it will last up to about 5 hours of conversation.

Storing names and telephone numbers in the phonebook

To use the phonebook on the main unit, you need to transfer the stored phonebook of the portable handset to the main unit. (You cannot store directly in the phonebook on the main unit.)

Store names and telephone numbers in the portable handset phonebook before using this feature (see page 13).

Transferring the phonebook entries from the portable handset to the main unit

■ To transfer all of the stored phonebook entries

• If you do not need to edit the name, skip to step 5.

5 Press ^{F1}.

b Enter the correct telephone number.

• If you do not need to edit the telephone number, skip to step 7.



8 Edit the group number.

• If you do not need to edit the group number, skip to step 9.



10 Press $\sqrt{10}$ (Off) to exit the program.

Intercom

An intercom is available between the portable handsets or between the main unit and portable handset(s).

Using the main unit:



■ For single portable handset users

1 Lift the handset.

② Press ^{内線} (Intercom).



■ For multiple portable handset users

- 1 Lift the handset.
- ② Press ^{内線} (Intercom).
- (3) Call the portable handset(s) in the following ways:
 - To call a specific portable handset, press the portable handset number (1) to 6) which you want to call.
 - To call all the portable handsets, press \bigotimes .

Using the portable handset (KX-FKN526):



- For single portable handset users Press 內線 (Intercom).
 - For multiple portable handset users
 - ① Press 内線 (Intercom).
 - ② Call the main unit and/or portable handset(s) in the following ways:
 - To call a specific portable handset, press the portable handset number (1 to 6) which you want to call.
 - To call the main unit, press 0.
 - To call the main unit and all the portable handsets, press *.

Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually



- Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- f 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.

3 If necessary, press $\overline{\mathbf{O}}$ (Resolution/Search button) repeatedly to select the desired resolution while " ガ シツ =" is displayed (see below).

4 Press (Fax).

5 Dial the fax number.

- 6 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing 画質/選択

(Standard) for printed or typewritten originals with normal-sized characters.

(Fine) for originals with minute printing.

Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

2 When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,

press $\overline{\gamma_{777}}$ (Fax), then replace the handset.

• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset (KX-FKN526):



When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger, then press $\widehat{\mathbb{M}}$ (Talk) to answer the call.

2 When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,

press $\overset{F1}{\bigcirc}$.

3 Press (Search button) repeatedly until the " אליד אי באי " is displayed, then press .

4 Press *****.

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- If the ^{𝔅𝔅} (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing ^{𝔅𝔅}.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.



2_{Press} **#** 1 4 7.



- 3 Press ^{機能/決定} (Function/Set).
- 4 Lift the handset.
- **5** Press $\bigcirc^{\frac{\#_{\mathbb{R}}/\chi_{\mathbb{R}}}{\bigcirc}}$ (Function/Set) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.

6 Press $\stackrel{\text{Xhy7}}{\ominus}$ (Stop) and replace the handset. • Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

Activating the answering device

Turn the 留守 (Auto answer) light on by pressing 留守.

 - To record your own greeting message, see left.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the $\textcircled{\text{GF}}$ (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press (to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

 \blacksquare To erase the messages, press (\bigstar) . ■ To save the messages, press (#).

Operating the answering device from a remote location



Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

- **1.** Press ^{機能/決定} (Function/Set).
- 2. Press # 0 0 6, then press ^{機能/決定} (Function/ Set).
- Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except × or #.

- **4.** Press ^{機能/決定} (Function/Set).
- 5. Press ⊖ (Stop).

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the ((Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- **3.** Press **2** or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4.

Blocking the incoming calls

Using the main unit:



To block a call using a message

While the unit is ringing, press 通話拒否 (Block).

OR

While you are on an incoming call, press 4 (Block), then press (\bigstar) .

The unit announces a message to the caller 2 times, then hangs up automatically. The message is announced in Japanese and means
"We're sorry, but your call cannot be connected.".

To block a call using chimes

While you are on an incoming call, press 通話拒否 (Block).

2 Press **(#**).

• Chimes are heard by the caller.

5 Explain to the caller that a visitor came and hang up.

For Number Display service subscribers

- If you subscribe to Number Display service, the message heard by the caller will change according to the caller's situation.
 - **Example :** If the caller requested not to send caller's information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean "Your phone number is blocked by service provider. Please call again with adding '186' to the beginning of the phone number."
- •When the following is displayed after blocking an incoming call, you can set the unit to block the call from the same telephone number.

Using the main unit:

- \blacksquare To block the call, press $\textcircled{\bigstar}$.
- To cancel blocking, press (#).
- When the following is displayed, press (#) to cancel.

• The unit announces a message to the caller 2 times, then hangs up automatically. The message is announced in Japanese and means "We're sorry, but your call cannot be connected.".

- Using the portable handset:
 - To block the call, press (\bigstar)
 - To cancel blocking, press (#)
