



Finding the controls



- 1 Liquid crystal display
 - The display turns off after about 2 minutes of inactivity.
 - To turn on the display, press ☐ (Stop).
- 2 Intercom button
- 3 Hold button
- 4 Speed Dialer button
- 5 Volume/Change/Redial/Phonebook key



- To adjust the volume (see below).
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.
- ■To adjust the **ringer volume** when the unit is on stand by



- ■To adjust the **receiver volume** while talking, press repeatedly.
- ■To adjust the **speaker volume** while listening to the recorded messages or using the monitor, press repeatedly.



To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.





How to use **buttons**

- While the portable handset is ringing, press this button. The portable handset announces a message to the caller. The message is announced in Japanese and means "This unit is currently set to Caller Verifying mode. Could you please speak out your name?"
 - ■To talk to the caller, press (外線).
 - ■To hung up, press (*



Mute button

 To mute your voice to the other party by pressing this button.

(To release the mute, press this button again.)



Erasing a specific message

Press $_{\overline{F1}}^{\overline{T9}}$ (More buttons), $\underline{_{F3}}^{\overline{H3}}$ (Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press $_{\overline{F1}}^{\overline{LU}}$ (Yes).

Erasing all of the recorded messages

- When not using an SD Memory Card, press はい (Yes).





Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings.
 This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.


