- To adjust the **speaker volume** while listening to the recorded messages or using the monitor, touch (大) (High) (小) (Low) repeatedly.

Installing the ink film 2 Open the control panel. **2** Open the back cover. Insert the ink film. Insert the orange gear into the left slot of the main unit. Insert the white gear into the right slot of the main unit. Δ If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding this gear (orange). 5 Close the back cover pressing " $\circ \circ \circ$ " down on both sides until it clicks into place. 6 Close the control panel.

Setting up the portable handset (KX-FKN518)

Press 😇 on the battery cover and slide the cover.

3 Connect the charger to the power outlet, then place the portable handset on the charger for about 10 hours.



• After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, it will last up to about 5 hours of conversation.

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message

You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.





3 Lift the handset.

4 Touch <u>開始</u> (Start) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.

5 Touch (End) and replace the handset.

• Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

Erasing your own greeting message



• The pre-recorded Japanese greeting message will be played when you receive a call.

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the 留守 (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- 3. Touch 2 or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4 after the new messages have been played back.

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Touch (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- "ジおやすみ" is displayed and 留守 lights on.
- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.

- **Example :** If the caller requested not to send caller's information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean "Your phone number is blocked by service provider. Please call again with adding '186' to the beginning of the phone number."
- •When the following is displayed after blocking an incoming call, you can set the unit to block the call from the same telephone number.

SD indicator

• The SD indicator appears on the display if an SD Memory Card has been inserted.



- The SD indicator flashes while reading or writing to the SD Memory Card.
- Never remove the card while the indicator is flashing.
