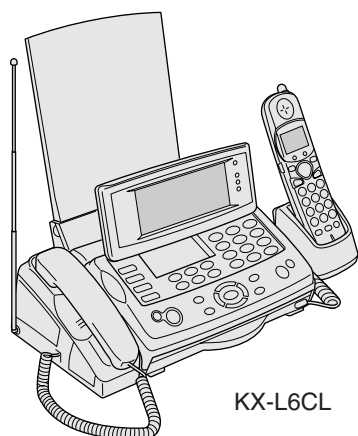

# Finding the controls

## Main unit (control panel)

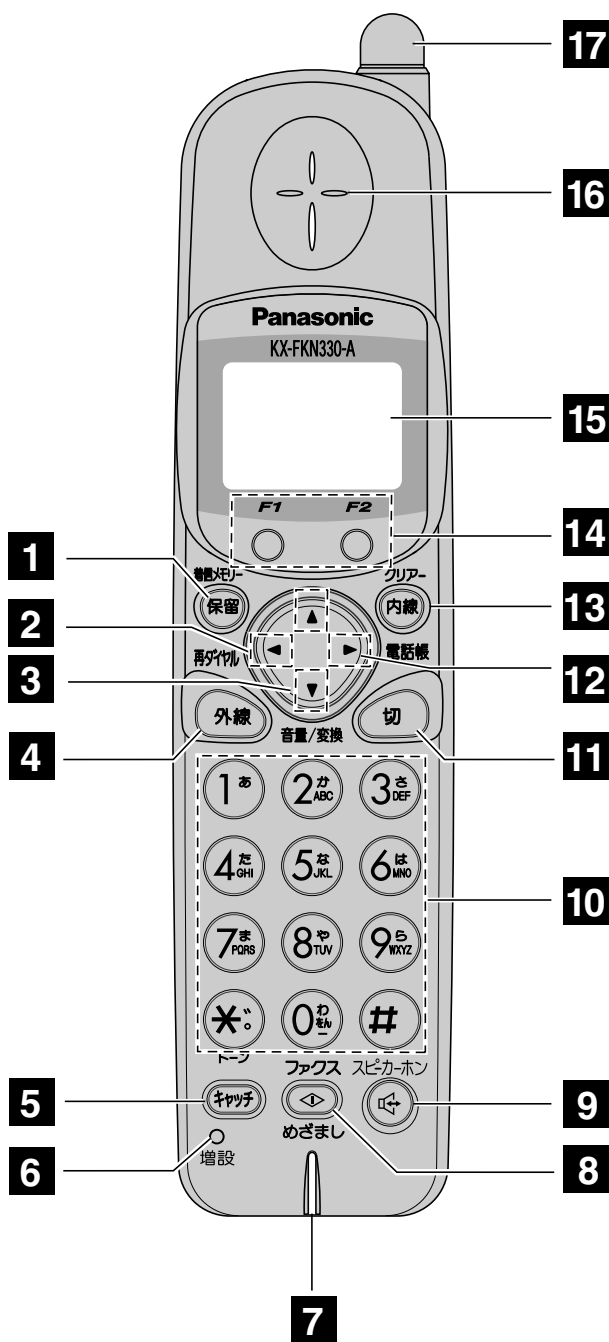


(KX-L6CW is shown.)

- 1** **Liquid crystal display**(With color)
- 2** **Volume** button adjusts ringer, speaker and handset volume.
- 3** **Fax View** button displays received fax List and fax data.
- 4** **Book mark** button
- 5** **Mail** button
- 6** **Clear** button
- 7** **Monitor** button starts On-Hook Dialing.
- 8** **Intercom** button
- 9** **Copy** button starts copying.
- 10** **Start/Fax** button starts faxing.
- 11** **Redial** button
- 12** **Stop** button
- 13** **Back** button returns previous display.
- 14** **Hold** button.
- 15**  **Cursor** button to move forward and backward in a text entry.
- 16**  **Flash** button uses the waiting service.
- 17**  **Phonebook** button uses the phonebook.

—light on: answering device activated.  
—light off: used as a regular telephone.

# Finding the controls

## Portable handset

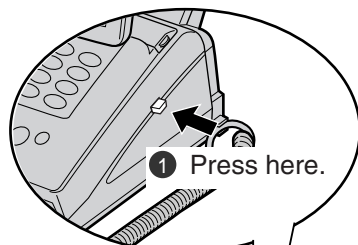


- 1 Caller information** button starts a search in the Number Display log. Hold button puts a call on hold.
- 2 Redial** button redials the last number dialed.
- 3 Volume** button adjusts the volume. **Search** button changes Hiragana into kanji.
- 4 Talk** button makes/answers calls.
- 5 Flash** button uses the call waiting service.
- 6** Used when installing additional portable handsets.
- 7 Microphone** [Do not cover the microphone while talking.]
- 8 Fax reception** receives faxes.
- 9 Speakerphone** button uses the speakerphone.
- 10 Dial** buttons  
**Tone** button switches to Tone dialing mode.  
**Sharp** button
- 11 Off** button ends a call, or ends/exits from editing and other operations.
- 12 Phonebook** button uses the phonebook.
- 13 Intercom** button pages the main unit or another portable handset.
- 14** Multi-operation buttons refer to the function displayed on the bottom of the display. They function differently depending on the mode.
- 15 Liquid crystal display** (with back light) displays battery strength, telephone numbers etc.
- 16 Speaker**
- 17 Call/charge indicator** will blink, when receiving a call or placed on a charger.

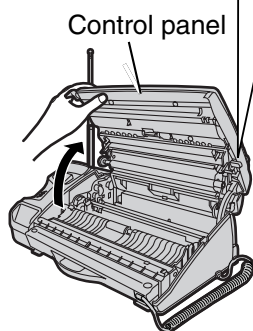
# Installations and connections

## Installing the ink film

- 1 Open the control panel.

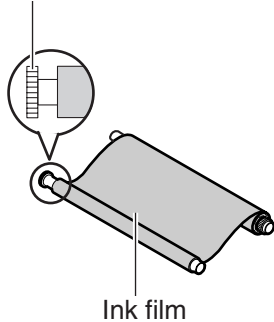


- 2 Open the control panel until it locks.

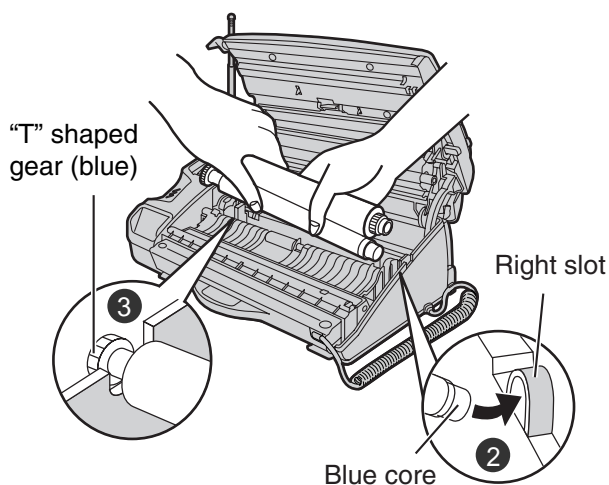


- 2 Insert the ink film.

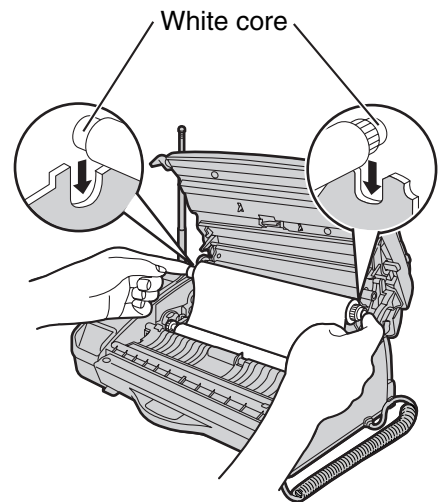
- 1 Find the "T" shaped gear (blue).



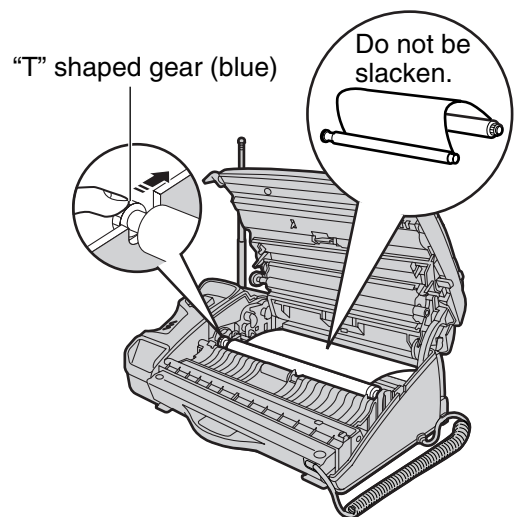
- 2 Insert the blue core into the right slot of the main unit.
- 3 Insert the "T" shaped gear (blue) into the left slot of the main unit.



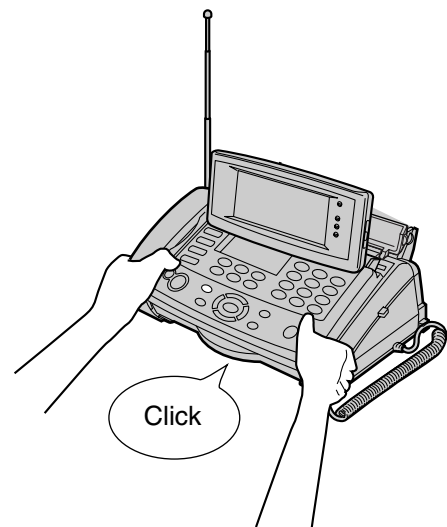
- 4 Insert the white core into the slots shown in the picture below.



- 5 If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding the "T" shaped gear (blue).



- 3 Close the control panel until it locks.

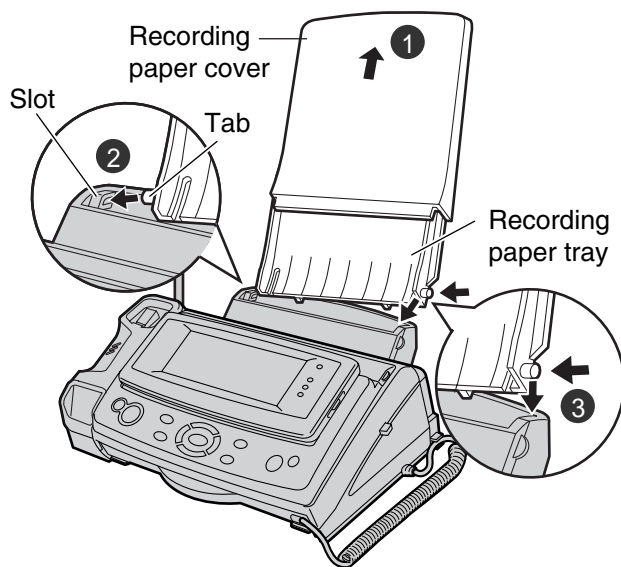


# Installations and connections

## Installing recording paper (A4 size)

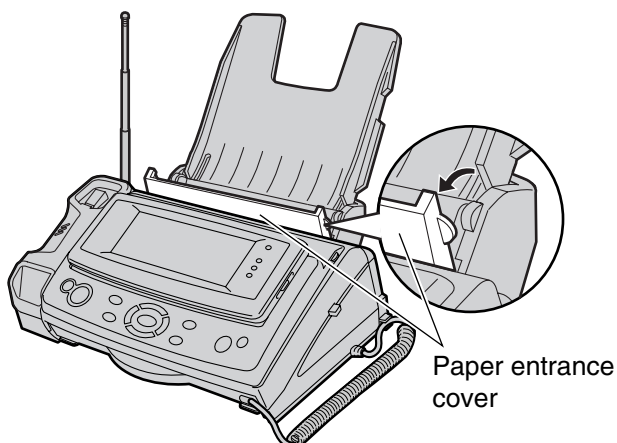
**1** Install the recording paper tray.

- 1 Remove the recording paper cover.
- 2 Insert the left tab on the recording paper tray into the left slot of the main unit.
- 3 Insert the right tab into the right slot of the main unit.

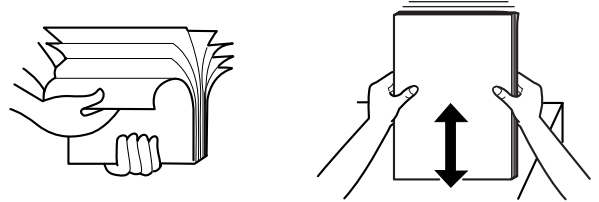


**2** Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray.

- 1 Open the paper entrance cover until it locks.

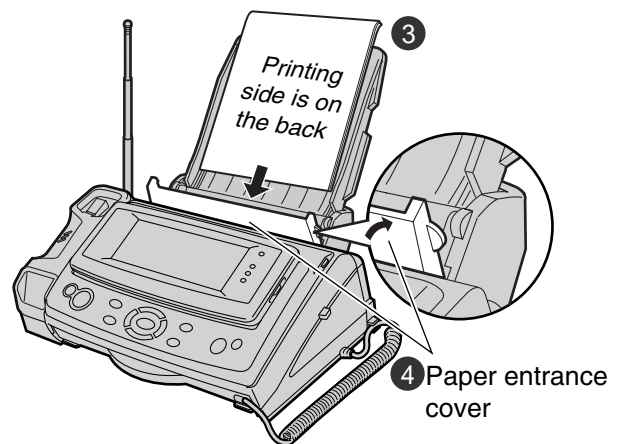


**2** Fan the stack of recording paper (A4 size).

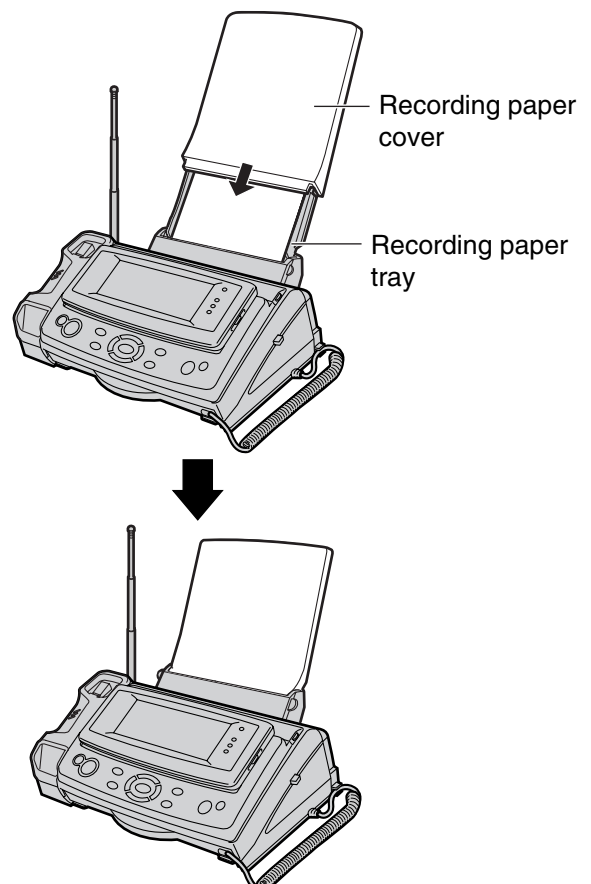


**3** Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray. (Up to 30 sheets)

**4** Close the paper entrance cover by leaning it back.



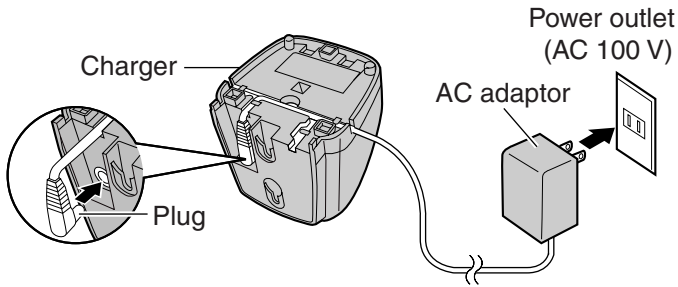
**3** Install the recording paper cover on the recording paper tray by sliding it down from the top.



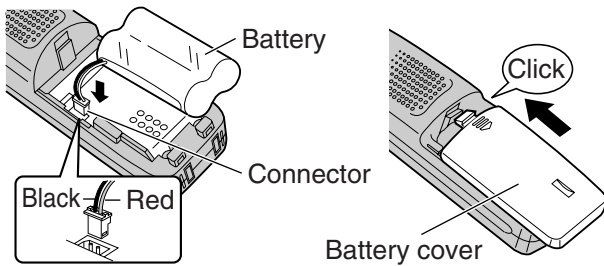

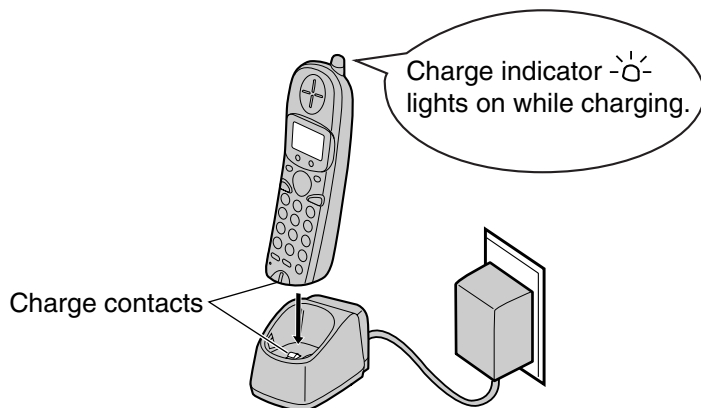

- After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, it will last up to about 7 hours of conversation.

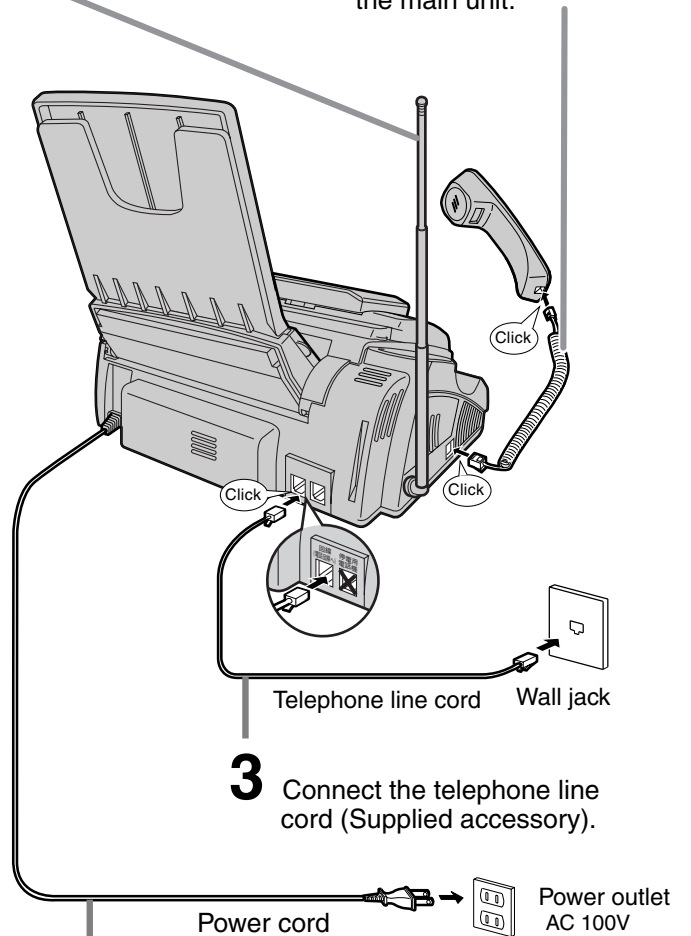

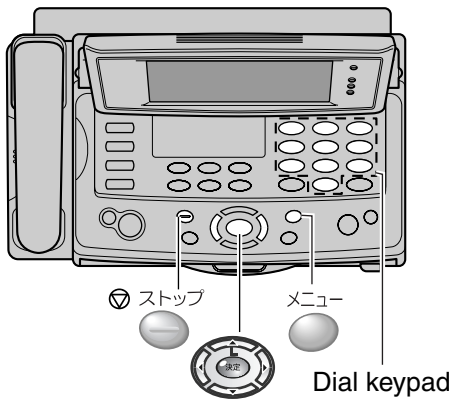

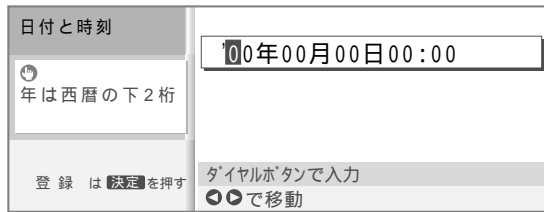

# Setting the date and time



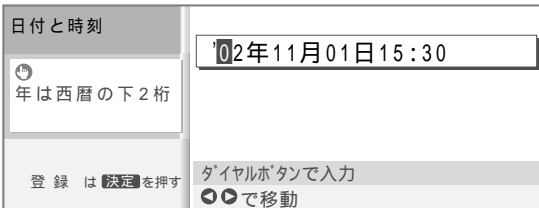

**Example: November 1, 2002, 15:30 (3:30 PM)**

Press **0** **2** **1** **1** **0** **1** **1** **5** **3** **0**.

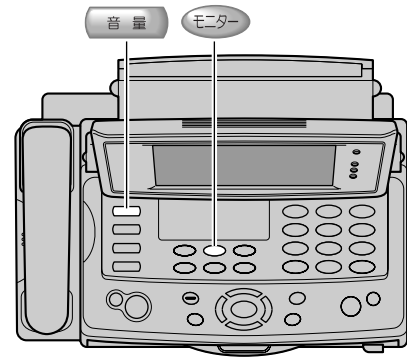

# Adjusting volumes

## Main unit



### ■ Ringer volume

5 levels (including off-position) are available.

Press **音量** (Volume) repeatedly while the unit is not in use.

### ■ Handset volume

4 levels are available.

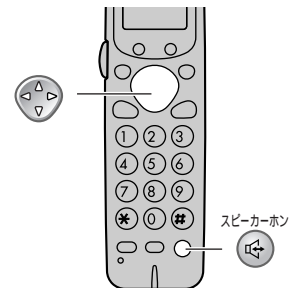
Press **音量** (Volume) repeatedly during telephone conversation.

### ■ Speaker volume

4 levels are available.

Press **音量** (Volume) repeatedly while using **モニター** or listening to the recorded messages.

## Portable handset



### ■ Ringer volume

4 levels (including off-position) are available.

Press **音量/変換** (Volume) repeatedly while the unit is not in use.

### To turn the ringer off:

Press and hold **音量/変換** (Volume) until a beep sounds.

### ■ Handset volume

3 levels are available.

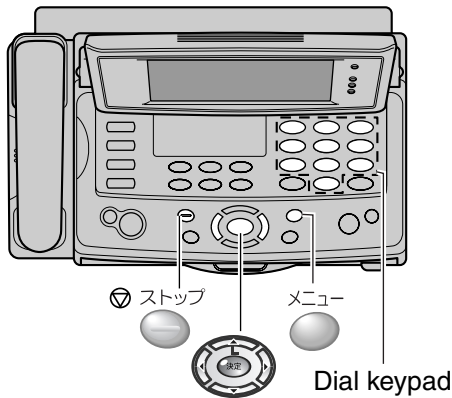
Press **音量/変換** (Volume) repeatedly during telephone conversation.

### ■ Speaker volume

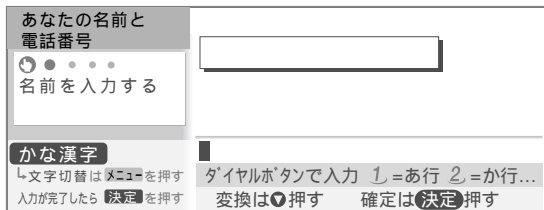
2 levels are available.

Press **音量/変換** repeatedly while using **スピーカホン** or listening to the recorded messages.

# Setting your logo and facsimile telephone number



**1** Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **5** **1** **1**.



**2** Enter your logo, up to 16 characters, using the dial keypad.

- To enter English characters, press **メニュー** (Menu), press **⏪** (down) three times to select “半角英字” (English and sign input mode), then press **決定** (Set).
- For details, see the table on page 9 for instructions.

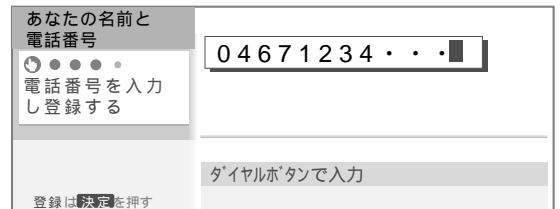


- To enter “M”, press **6** **は** once.
- To enter “i”, press **4** **た** six times.
- To enter “c”, press **2** **か** six times.
- To enter “a”, press **⏩** (right) to move the cursor to the next space and press **2** **か** four times.
- To enter “h”, press **4** **た** five times.

**3** Press **決定** (Set) twice.

**4** Enter your facsimile telephone number, up to 20 digits.

**Example: 04671234••**



**5** Press **決定** (Set).




**6** Press **ストップ** (Stop).

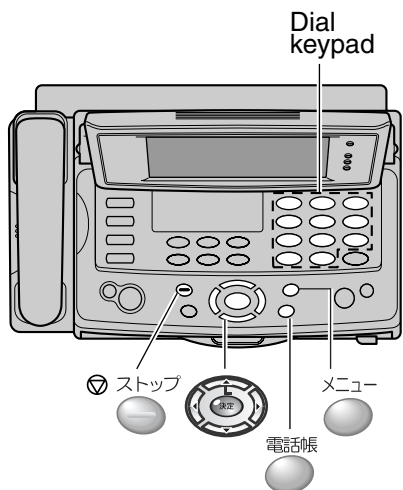

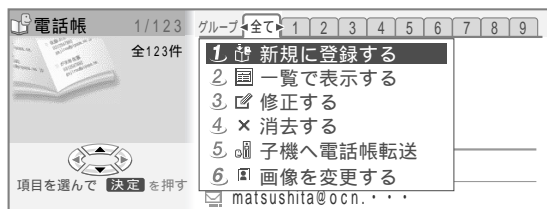
# Automatic dialing on the main unit

## Storing names and telephone numbers in the phonebook



**1** Press (Phonebook), (Menu) and (Set).

- You can program up to 150 stations, including 4 pre-programmed stations.



**2** Enter the name, up to 20 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions).

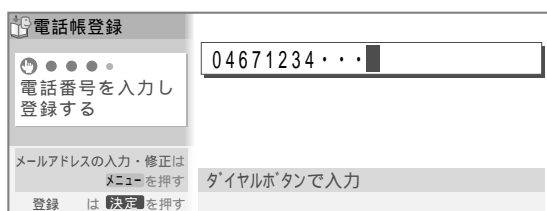
- To enter English characters, press (Menu), press (down) three times to select “半角英字” (English and sign input mode), then press (Set).

- To correct a mistake, press (Clear).



**3** Press (Set) twice.

**4** Enter the telephone number, up to 24 digits.



**5** Press (Set).

**6** Press (up or down) to select a group number (1–9).

**7** Press (Set).

**8** Press (Stop) to exit the program.

## Making a voice call using the phonebook

**1** Press (Phonebook).

**2** Press (up or down) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

**3** Lift the handset.

## Editing a stored name or number

**1** Press (Phonebook).

**2** Press (up or down) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

**3** Press (Menu) and (3).

**4** Edit the name (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press (Set).

**5** Enter the correct kana, then press (Set).

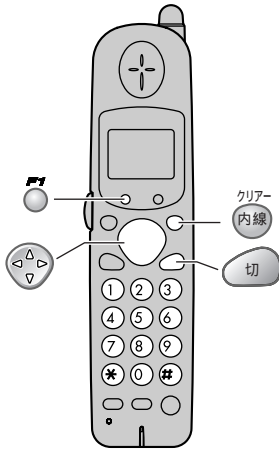
**6** Enter the correct telephone number, then press (Set).

**7** Press (up or down) to select a group number, then press (Set).

**8** Press (Stop) to exit the program.

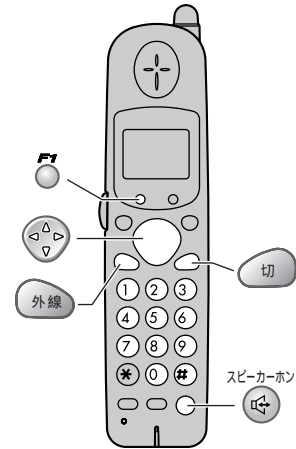

• To program other items, repeat steps 3 to 8.

9 Press (Off) to exit the program.

## Making a voice call using the phonebook



1 Press (Phonebook).

2 Press (up or down) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

3 Press (Talk) or press (Speakerphone).

## Editing a stored name or number

1 Press (Phonebook).

2 Press (up or down) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

3 Press (Edit).

4 Edit the name (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press (Register).

5 Enter the correct kana, then press (Register).

6 Enter the correct telephone number.  
• To correct a mistake, press (Clear).

7 Press (Register).

8 Enter the correct group number.

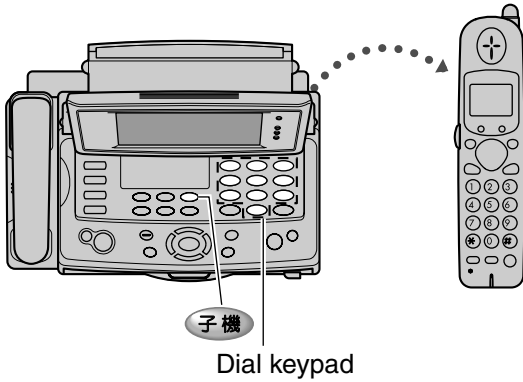

# Intercom between the main unit and portable handset

An intercom is available between the main unit and portable handset.

## Using the main unit:



**1** Lift the handset.

■ **For single portable handset users**

Press **子機** (Portable handset).

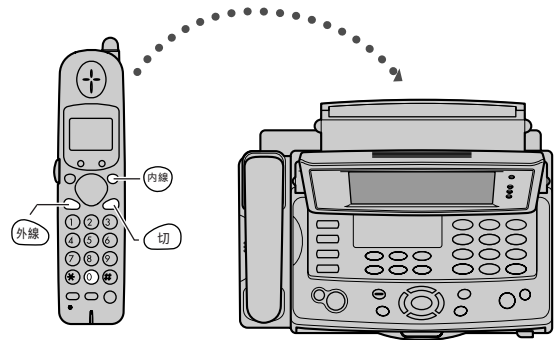
■ **For multiple portable handset users**

Press **子機** (Portable handset) and press the portable handset number ( **1** あ to **4** た ) which you want to call.

**2** Start talking.

**3** Replace the handset.

## Using the portable handset:



**1** ■ **For single portable handset users**

Press **内線** (Intercom), then press **0**.

**2** Start talking.

- You can switch to the speakerphone by pressing

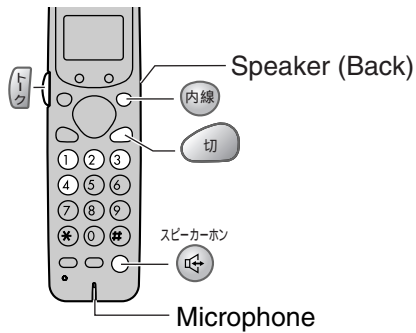

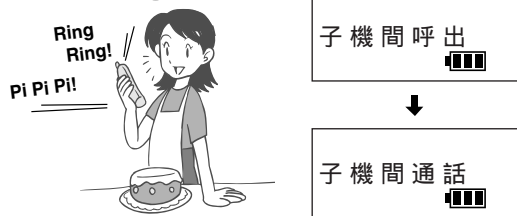

## Making an intercom call



- 1** Press (Intercom) and the desired portable handset number (**1** to **4**).



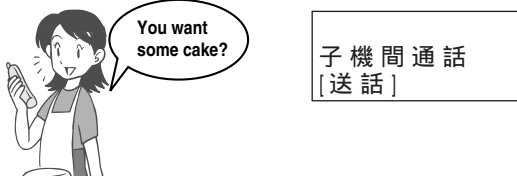
- 2** Start talking.

1. Press and hold (Talk) until a beep sounds.

- light on

2. Start talking while holding down (Talk).

- Keep holding down (Talk) until you finish talking.



3. Release (Talk) after you finish talking.

- 3** Listen to the response.

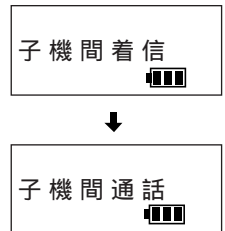
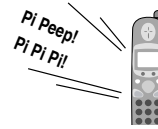


- 4** If you want to continue the conversation, repeat steps 2 and 3.

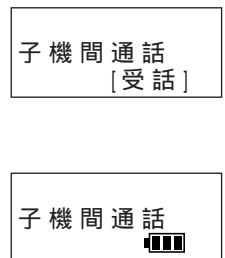
- 5** Press (Off) to end the intercom call.

## Answering an intercom call

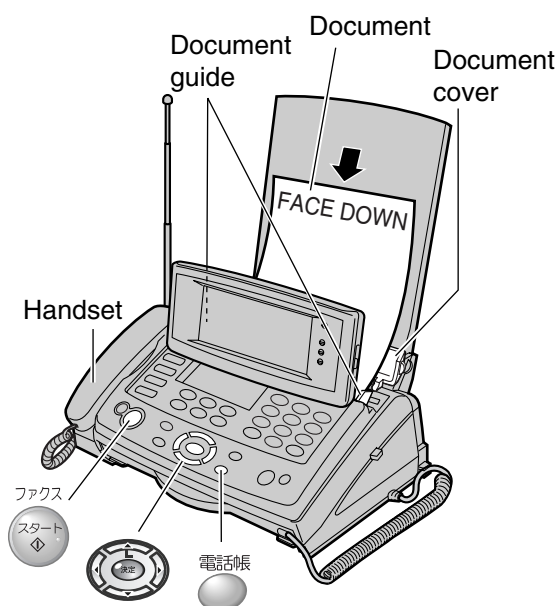
# Sending faxes

## Sending a fax manually



- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press (Resolution) and (up or down) to select the desired resolution (see below).
- 4 Dial the fax number.
- 5 Press (Fax).
  - The unit will start fax transmission.

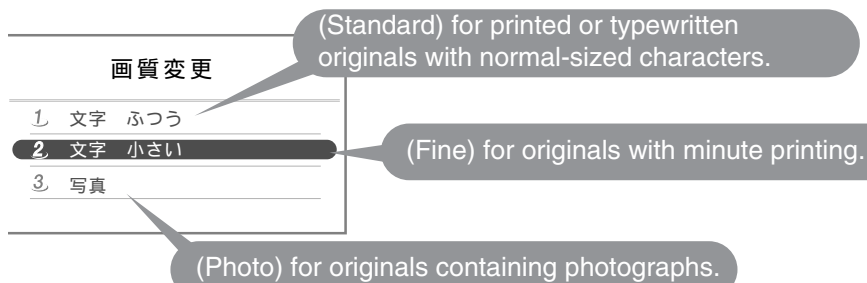
## Sending a fax using the phonebook



- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press (Resolution) and (up or down) to select the desired resolution (see below).
- 4 Press (Phonebook), then press (up or down) until the desired name is displayed.
- 5 Press (Fax).
  - The unit will start fax transmission.

### To select the resolution

1. Press (Resolution) after loading documents.
2. Press (up or down) to select the desired resolution.



# Receiving faxes

You can select beforehand whether to receive faxes by “Receive in memory” or “Receive on recording paper”.

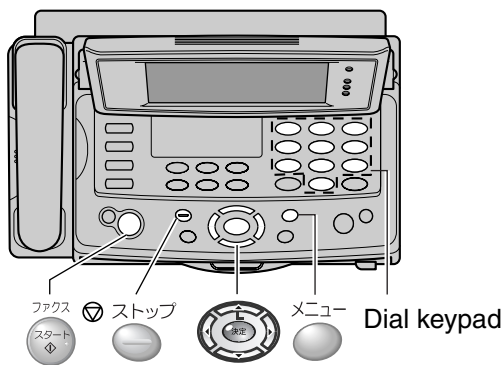
## Receive in memory: (Default setting)

The received fax will be stored in memory. You can check the contents on the display, then print them if necessary.

## Receive on recording paper:

The received fax will be printed on recording paper.

## Setting/canceling “Receive in memory”



**1** Press (Menu) and (6).

**2** Press (up or down) to select either “Receive in memory” or “Receive on recording paper” and press (Set).

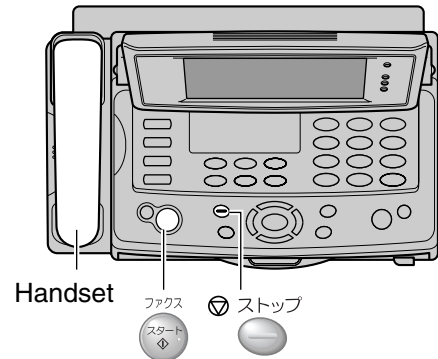


**3** Press (Stop).



## Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:

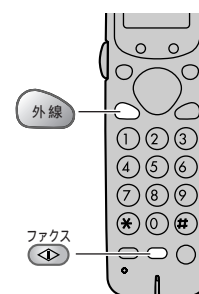


**1** When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

**2** When: –document reception is required, –a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or –no sound is heard, press (Fax).

**3** Replace the handset.  
• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset:

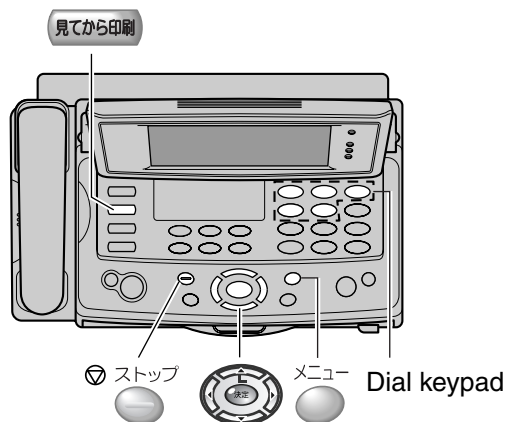


**1** When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.  
• If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).

**2** When: –document reception is required, –a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or –no sound is heard, press (Fax reception) until a single beep is heard.  
• The main unit will start fax reception.

# Receiving faxes

## Viewing faxes stored in memory



**1** While “ファクスを受信しました” (A fax has been received) is displayed, press **決定** (Set).

- When “ファクスを受信しました” (A fax has been received) is not displayed, press **見てから印刷** (Fax list).

**2** Press (up or down) to select the desired fax to display.

shows the fax has not been viewed yet.



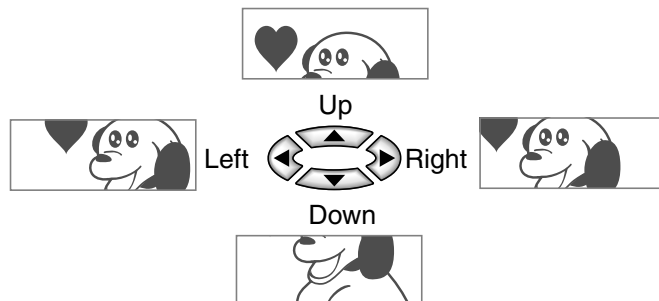
**3** Press **決定** (Set) to see the fax (follow the instructions on the right).



**4** To close the fax, press **ストップ** (Stop).

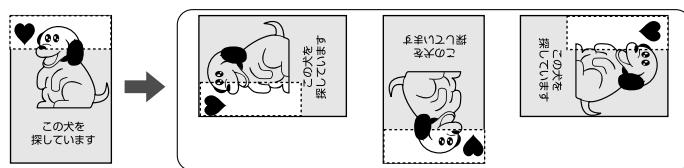

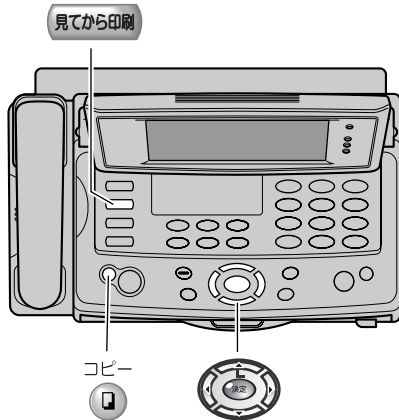

## Printing a specific fax stored in memory



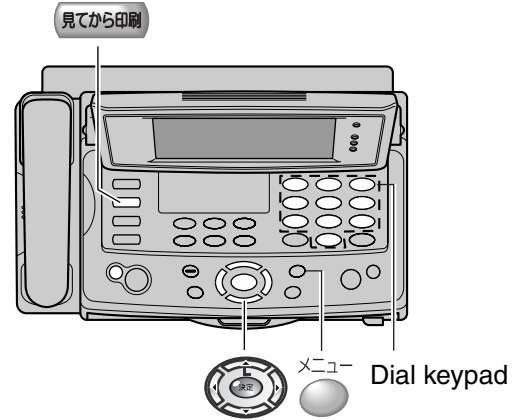
- 1 While “ファクスを受信しました” (A fax has been received) is displayed, press **決定** (Set).
  - When “ファクスを受信しました” (A fax has been received) is not displayed, press **見てから印刷** (Fax list).

- 2 Press **↑/↓** (up or down) to select the desired fax to print.

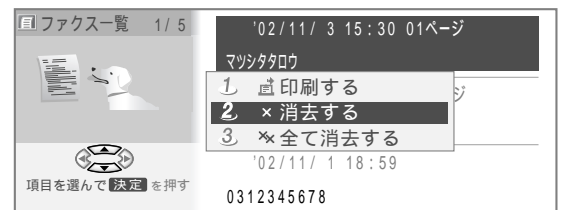


- 3 Press **コピー** (Copy).

## Deleting a specific fax stored in memory



- 1 Press **見てから印刷** (Fax list).
- 2 Press **↑/↓** (up or down) to select the desired fax to delete.
- 3 Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **2** (Delete a specific fax).



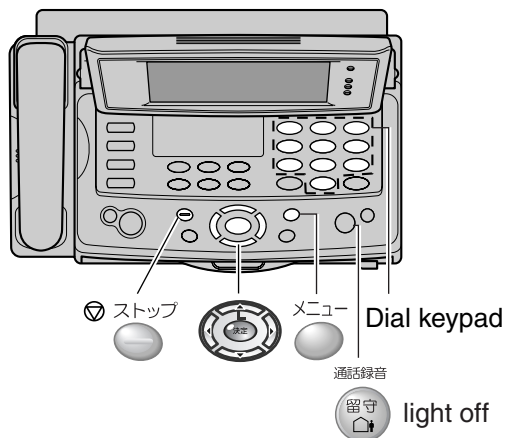
- 4 To delete the fax, select “はい” (Yes).

## Deleting all faxes stored in memory

- 1 Press **見てから印刷** (Fax list).
- 2 Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **3** (Delete all faxes).
- 3 To delete all the faxes, select “はい” (Yes).

# Receiving faxes

## Setting ANSWER mode



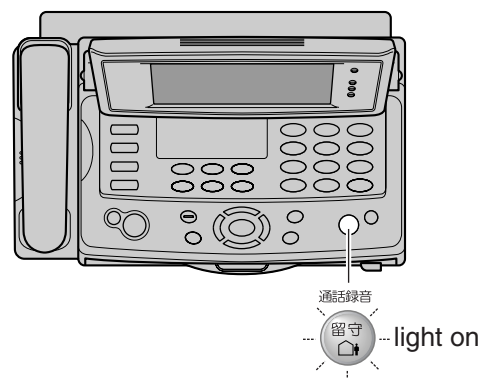
When AUTO ANSWER mode is off, the unit provides three types of receiving modes: “電話モード” (Telephone) mode, “ファクス優先” (Fax/Telephone) mode and “ファクス専用” (Fax only) mode.

- 1. Telephone mode (電話モード)** –Pre-selected setting:  
Select this mode when you plan to answer the calls yourself.  
When receiving calls, you have to answer all calls manually.
- 2. Fax/Telephone mode (ファクス優先):** Select this mode when you are near the unit and want to use it to receive voice calls yourself and fax calls automatically.
- 3. Fax only mode (ファクス専用):** Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a fax machine.

### Changing the setting of ANSWER mode.

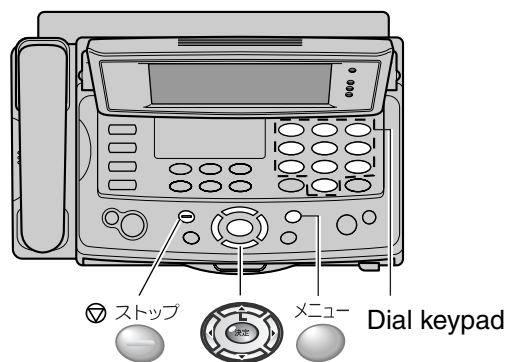
1. Press (Menu) and .
2. Press (up or down) repeatedly to select the desired mode.
3. Press (Set).
4. Press (Stop) to exit the program.

## Setting AUTO ANSWER mode



- 1** If the (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing .
- 2** When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

## Recording your own greeting message

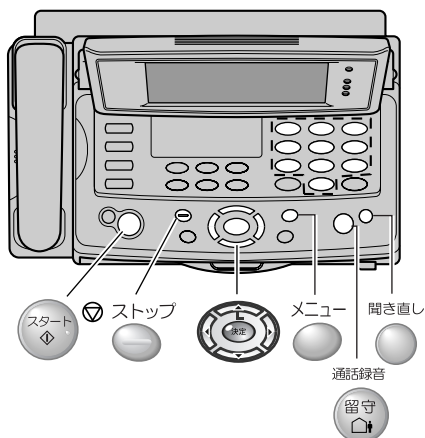


You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1** Press (Menu) and .
- 2** Lift the handset.
- 3** Press (Set) and record your greeting message, up to 30 seconds, using the handset.
- 4** When finished, replace the handset.
  - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.
- 5** Press (Stop) twice.

# Operating the built-in answering device

## Activating the answering device



- 1 Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
  - To record your own greeting message, see page 18.

## Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the **留守** (Auto answer) light will flash.

- 1 Press **留守** to listen to the recorded messages.
- 2 To erase the messages, press **決定** (Set) within 10 seconds after playing back.  
To save the messages, press **ストップ** (Stop).

## Listening to all of the recorded messages

Press **聞き直し** (Replay/Record).

While a message is played back, the following operations are available:

To listen to the next message, press **聞き直し** (right).

To listen to the previous message, press **聞き直し** (left).

To play back faster, press **1**.

To play back slowly, press **2**.

To erase the message being played back, press **3**.

To erase all the recorded messages, press

**4**.

To stop playing back, press **ストップ** (Stop).

## Erasing all of the recorded messages

- 1 Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **5** **9** **9** **スタート**.
- 2 Press **ストップ** (Stop).

## Erasing your own greeting message

- 1 Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **5** **9** **0** **スタート**.
- 2 Press **ストップ** (Stop).
  - The pre-recorded Japanese greeting message will be played when you receive a call.

## Operating the answering device from a remote location

Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

1. Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **5** **3** **0**.
2. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except \* or #.
3. Press **決定** (Set).
4. Press **ストップ** (Stop).

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

1. Call your unit.
2. Press **#** during the greeting message, then enter the remote operation ID and **#**.
3. Press **2** **#**.
  - The recorded messages will be played back.

## Using L-mode service

“L-mode” is a convenient service of NTT offering with web browsing and e-mail.

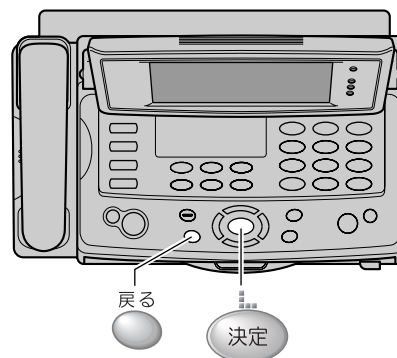

## Setting up L-mode service

You should set up your unit before using L-mode service.

### Important:

- You should set up your unit after subscription of “L-mode” service is completed.  
You cannot set up your unit until the service becomes available.
- When your unit is turned off, the required data for L-mode is deleted and L-mode service will not be available.  
The following setting is necessary to use L-mode service again after switching on the power supply.



- 1 Press (L-mode) twice.
  - The required data for L-mode will be downloaded.

- 2 Press (Set) after “設定完了” is displayed.



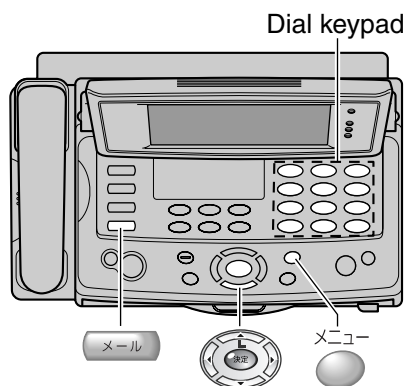
- You can use L-mode service continuously.

- 3 Press (Back) repeatedly until the top menu is displayed.

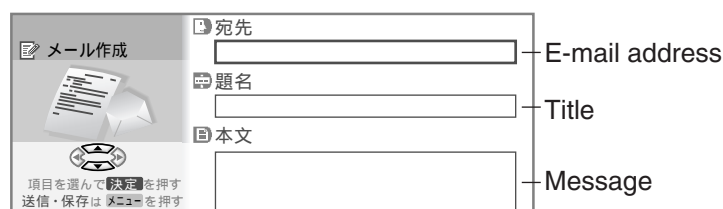
- 4 Press (Back), then press (Set).

## Sending an e-mail



**1** Press **メール** (Mail), then press **決定** (Set).



**2** Press **決定** (Set).

**3** Enter the desired e-mail address, up to 50 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press **決定** (Set).

• You can enter the e-mail address using the addressbook.

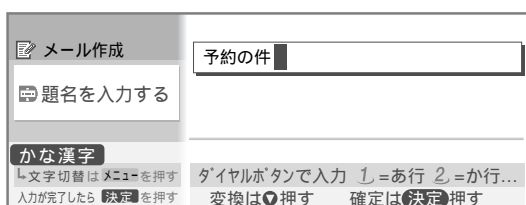
1. Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **3**.

2. Press **決定** (Down) to select the desired party.

3. Press **決定** (Set).

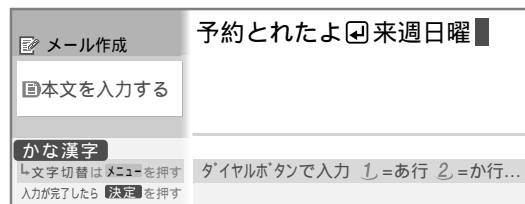
**4** Press **決定** (Down) to select the title column, then press **決定** (Set).

**5** Enter the title of your e-mail, up to 60 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press **決定** (Set).



**6** Press **決定** (Down) to select the message column, then press **決定** (Set).

**7** Enter your e-mail message, up to 2000 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press **決定** (Set).



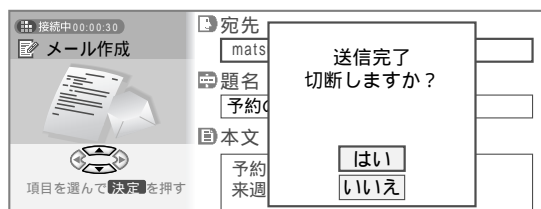
**8** ■ To send the e-mail

Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **1**.  
• Your e-mail will be sent.

■ To stop writing the e-mail and save it

Press **メニュー** (Menu) and **2**.

**9** When the following is displayed, select “はい” (Yes) to disconnect the line.

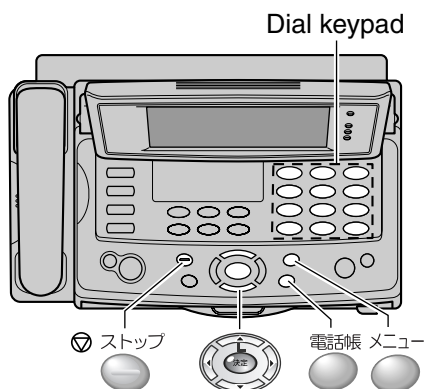
