Setting up the portable handset (KX-FKD503)

Press on the battery cover and slide the cover off.

Connect the charger to the power outlet, then place the portable handset on the charger for about **10 hours**.



• After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, it will last up to about 5 hours of conversation.

 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 5 after the new messages have been played back.

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press 🛪 (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.
