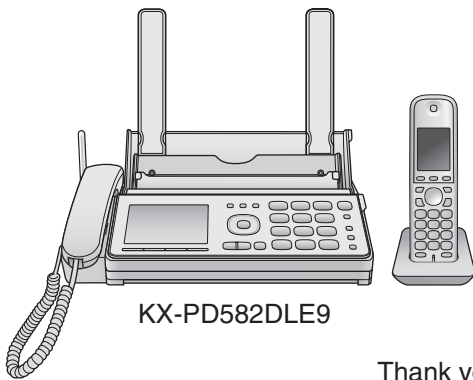

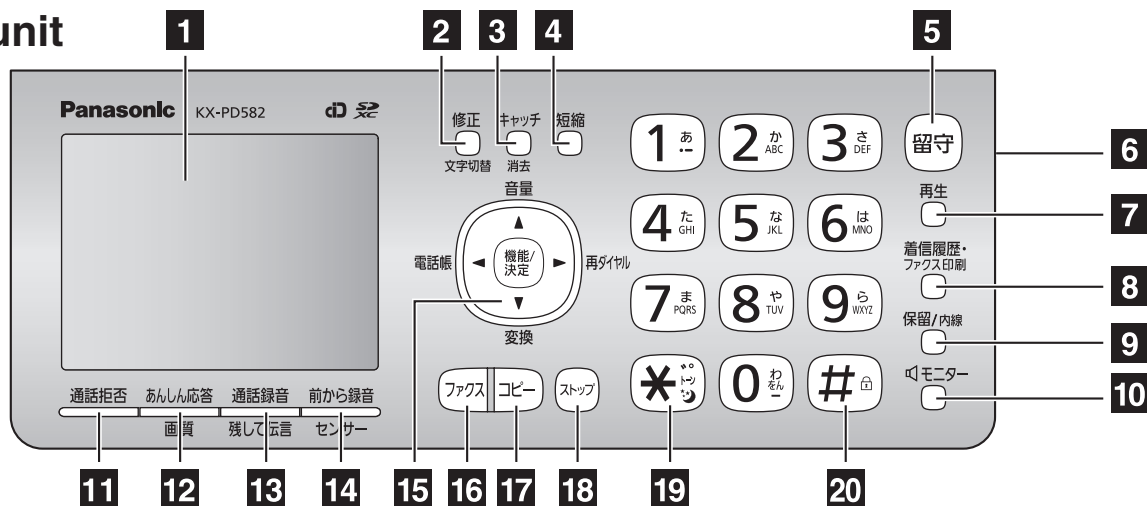

Finding the controls

Main unit



1 Liquid crystal display

2 Edit/Character Input Mode button

3 Flash button (For call waiting service users.)
Erase button

4 Speed Dialer button

5 Auto Answer button & indicator
— light on: answering device activated.
— light off: used as a regular telephone.

6 SD Memory Card slot (See page 24)

7 Playback button plays back recorded messages.

8 Caller ID Log/Fax Print button starts a search in
— the Number Display (Caller ID) log.
— the fax list stored in memory.
Caller ID Log/Fax Print indicator lights when
— a call was missed. (For Number Display service users.)
— a fax was stored in memory.

9 Hold/Intercom button

10 Monitor button

11 Block button for undesired calls

12 Secure button



While the unit is ringing, press this button. The unit announces a message to the caller. The message is announced in Japanese and means “This unit is currently set to Caller Verifying mode. Could you please speak out your name?”.

- To talk to the caller, lift the handset.
- To hang up, press .

Resolution button selects the resolution when faxing or copying.

13 Record button records a telephone conversation.



14 Enhanced Record button records the previous 10 minutes of the current telephone conversation. If an SD Memory Card is available (inserted), the telephone conversation will be recorded to the SD Memory Card.



- To record the previous 10 minutes of telephone conversation, press  (Enhanced record).
- To stop recording, press  (Stop).


15 Volume/Change/Phonebook/Redial key





- To adjust the volume (see below).
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.

■ To adjust the **ringer volume** when the unit is on stand by, press   (Select “呼出音量変更”)

➔  (Function/Set) ➔  (press repeatedly)

➔  (Stop).

■ To adjust the **receiver volume** while talking, press  repeatedly.

■ To adjust the **speaker volume** while listening to the recorded messages or using the monitor, press  repeatedly.



To use the phonebook.

To register a function or apply a setting.

16 Fax button starts faxing.

17 Copy button starts copying.





Key lock button can lock the main unit so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.

How to use , , buttons

- ,  and  buttons refer to the function displayed on the bottom of the display. They function differently depending on the mode.
- To answer a second call on the other call, press . (For call waiting service users.)

-  To put a call on hold.
-  To page the main unit and/or portable handset(s).



- To make/answer calls.



- To end a call.
- To end or exit from editing or other operations.

Microphone

Do not cover the microphone while talking.

Dial buttons



- Tone button
 - To switch to tone dialing.

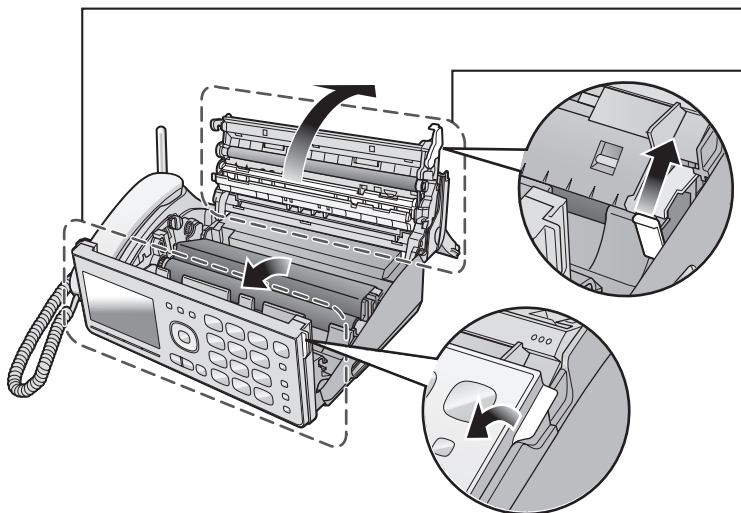

- Key lock button

- To lock the portable handset so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.
- To turn key lock off, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.

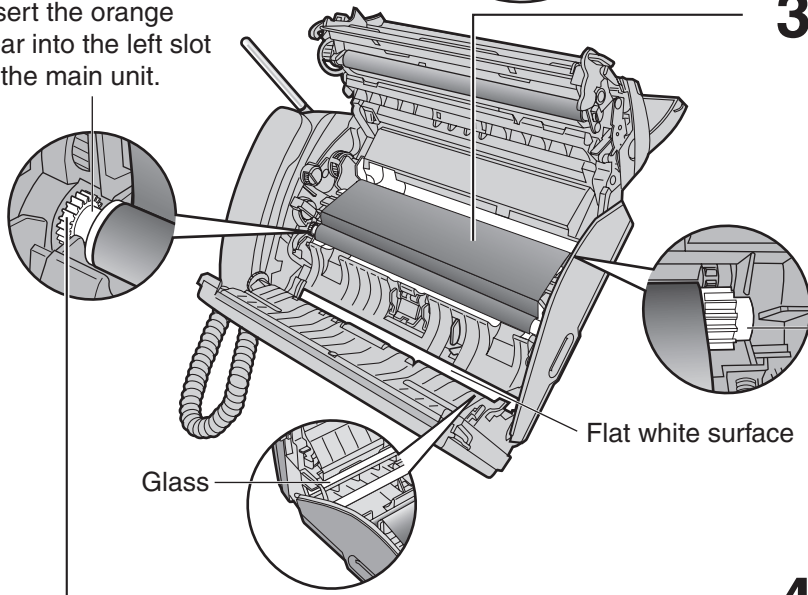
Installations and connections

Installing the ink film



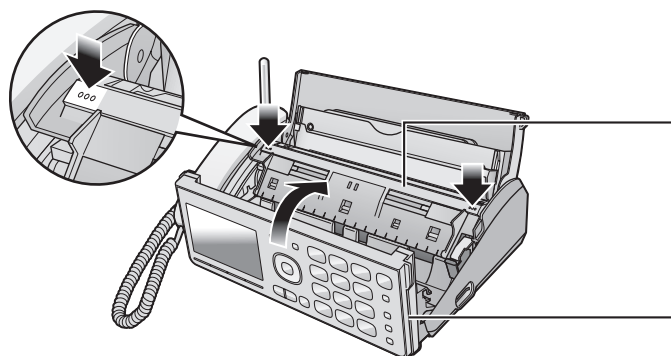
- 1** Open the control panel.
- 2** Pull up the green lever and open the back cover.

Insert the orange gear into the left slot of the main unit.



- 3** Insert the ink film.
 - Do not place the ink film on the back side of the control panel. Any ink adhering to the glass or flat white surface may cause black or white lines to appear on the recording paper or the recipient's fax.

Insert the white gear into the right slot of the main unit.



- 4** If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding this gear (orange).
- 5** Close the back cover pressing “○○○” down on both sides until it clicks into place.
- 6** Close the control panel.

• When the unit runs out of the ink film, the following message will be displayed.

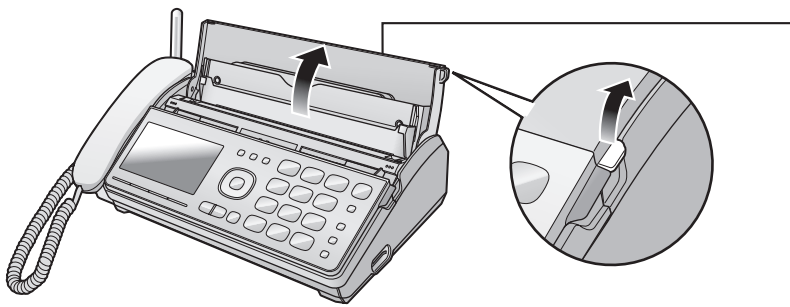

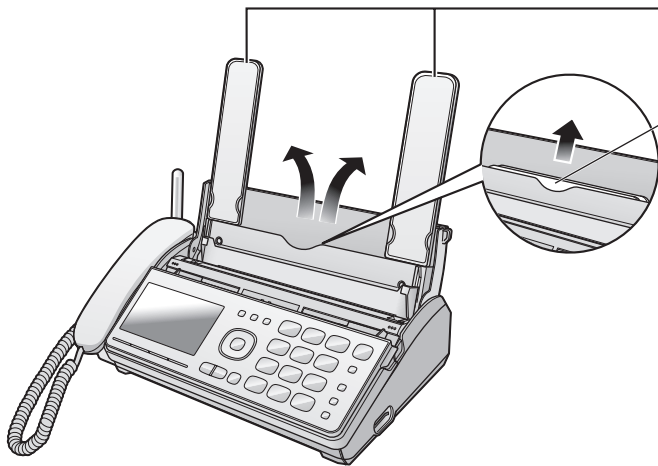

Installing recording paper (A4 size)

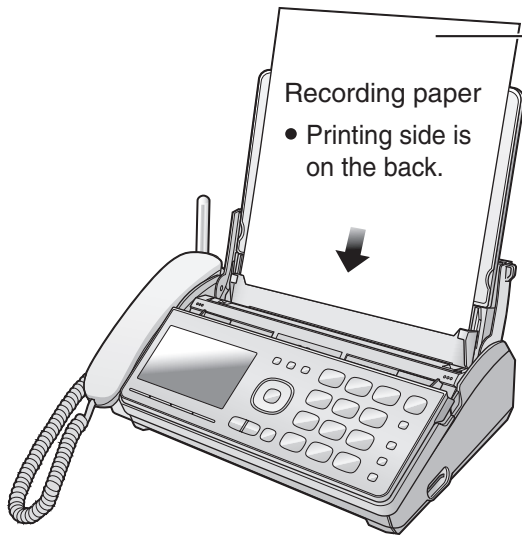


1 Open the recording paper tray.



2 Set up the recording paper stands.

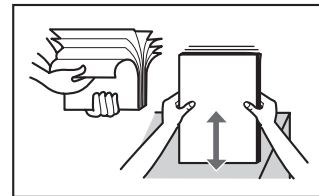
Pull out the front stand first.

3 Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray. (Up to 15 sheets)

- Fan the stack of recording paper.

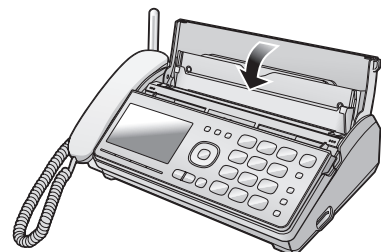


Folding the recording paper tray

① Remove the recording paper and fold the recording paper stands in.

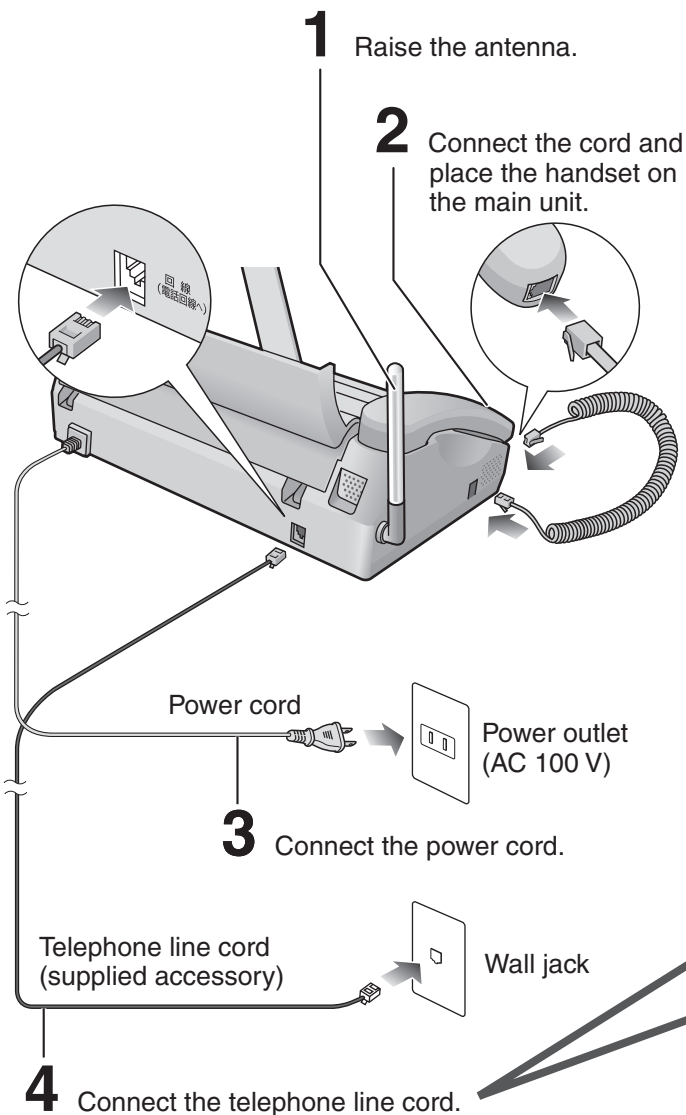


② Close the recording paper tray.

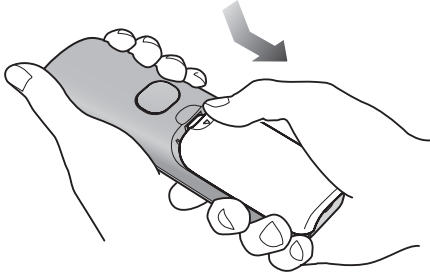

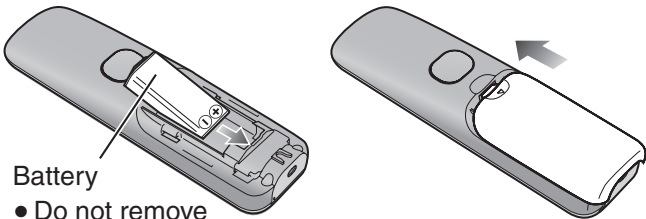

Setting up the portable handset (KX-FKD504)

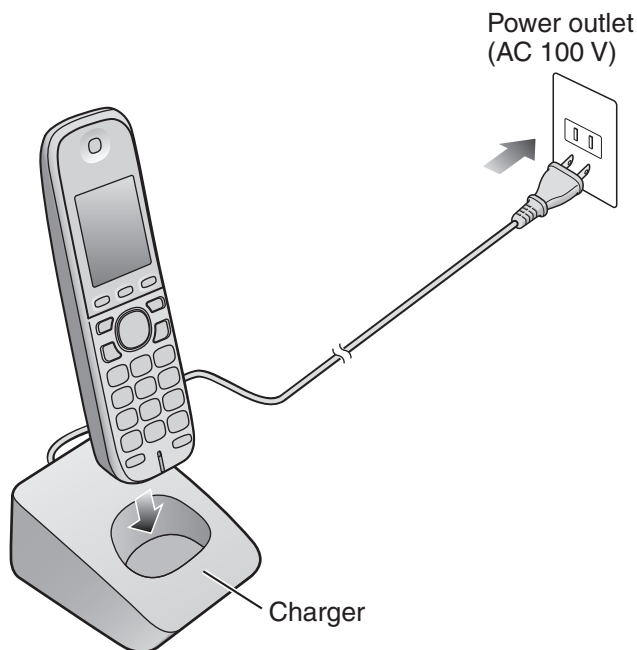

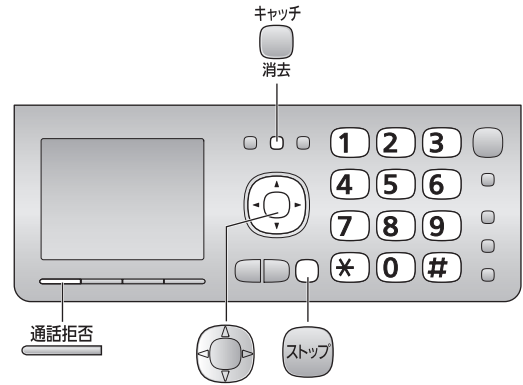

- 3** Connect the charger to the power outlet, then place the portable handset on the charger for about **10 hours**.



• After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, it will last up to about 5 hours of conversation.

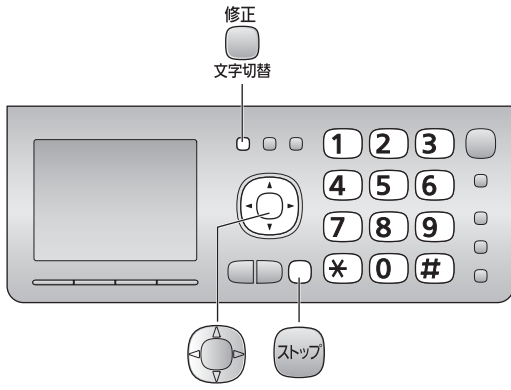

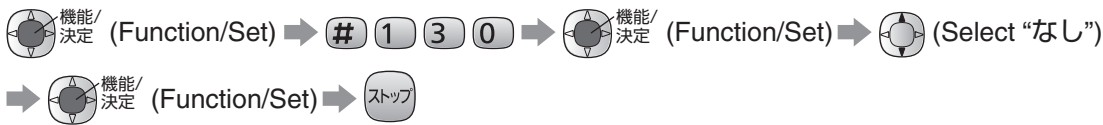

Reading-out dial

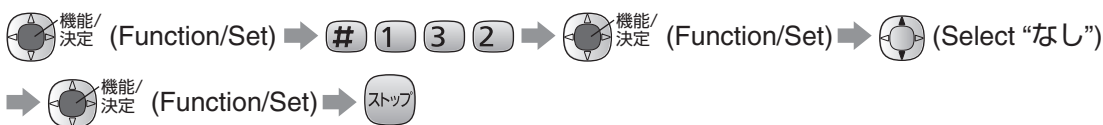

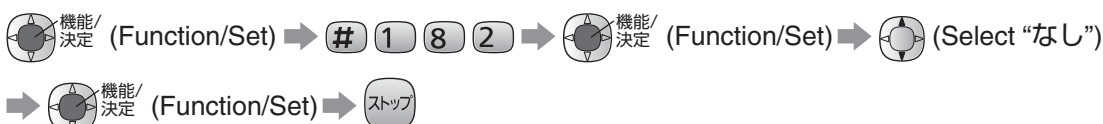

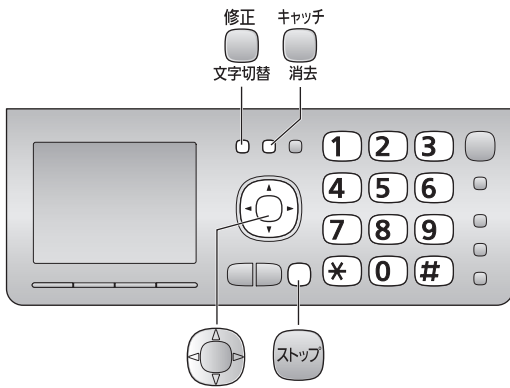

- If you do not need to edit the telephone number, skip to step 9.

9 Press (Function/Set).

10 Edit the group number.

- If you do not need to edit the group number, skip to step 11.

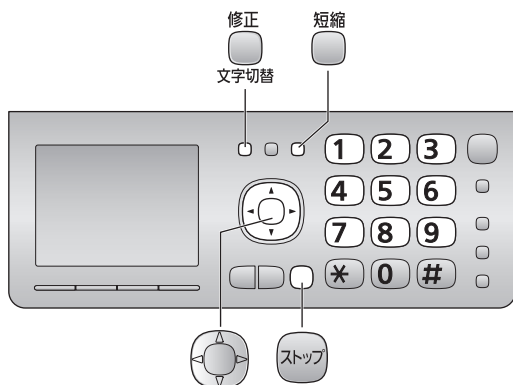

Automatic dialing on the main unit

Storing names and telephone numbers in the speed dialer

You can store up to 9 names and telephone numbers which are stored in the phonebook. The dialing buttons (1) to (9) function as memory stations.



- 1 Press (Speed dialer).
- 2 Press the memory station number (1) to (9).

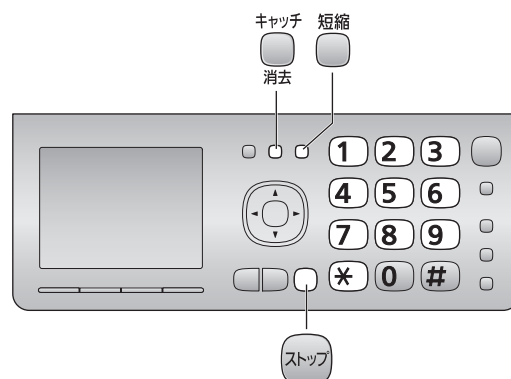

- 4 Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

- 5 Press (Function/Set).
 - To store other items, repeat steps 2 to 5.

- 6 Press (Stop) to exit.

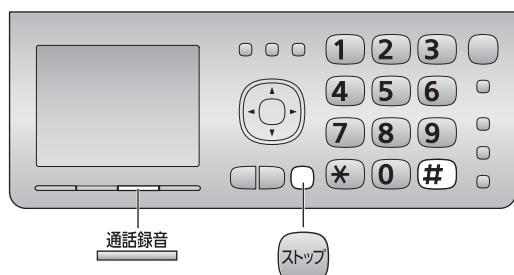

Erasing a stored name and number in the speed dialer

- 1 Press (Speed dialer).
- 2 Press the memory station number (1) to (9).
- 3 Press (Flash/Erase), then press (*).
- 4 Press (Stop) to exit.

Recording a telephone conversation on the main unit

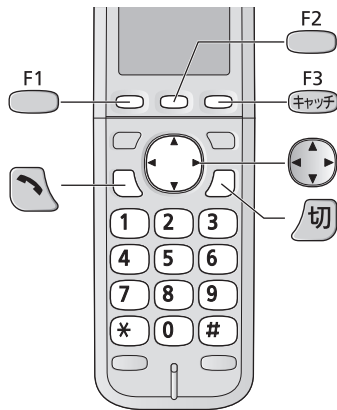
If an SD Memory Card is available (inserted), the telephone conversation will be recorded to the SD Memory Card.



- 1 While talking, press (Record).
- 2 Press (#) (Cancel the precaution voice message) and the recording starts.
- 3 Press (Stop) to end the recording.

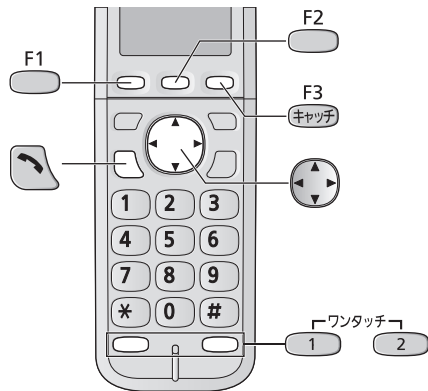

Automatic dialing on the portable handset (KX-FKD504)

Storing names and telephone numbers in the one-touch dialer

You can store up to 2 phonebook entries as the one-touch dialer.



- 1 Press **F1**.
- 2 Press the one-touch dial button (**ワンタッチ 1** or **ワンタッチ 2**).

Erasing a stored name and number in the one-touch dialer

- 1 Press **F1**.
- 2 Press the one-touch dial button (**ワンタッチ 1** or **ワンタッチ 2**).
 - To check the telephone number, press **F1**.
- 3 Press **F3** (**キャッチ**).
- 4 Press **F1**.

Recording a telephone conversation on the portable handset (KX-FKD504)

If an SD Memory Card is available (inserted), the telephone conversation will be recorded to the SD Memory Card.

- 1 While talking, press **F1**.
- 2 Press **Search button** repeatedly until “通話録音” is displayed, then press **F2**.
- 3 Press **Search button** repeatedly until “しない” is displayed, then press **F2** and the recording starts.

- 4 ■ To end the recording
 - ① Press **F1**.

Intercom

An intercom is available between the portable handsets or between the main unit and portable handset(s).

Using the main unit:




1 ■ For single portable handset users

- ① Press  (Hold/Intercom).

- ② Call the portable handsets in the following ways:
 - To call a specific portable handset, press the portable handset number (**1** to **6**) which you want to call.

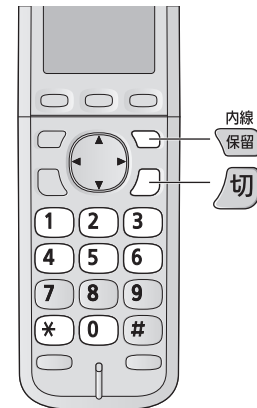

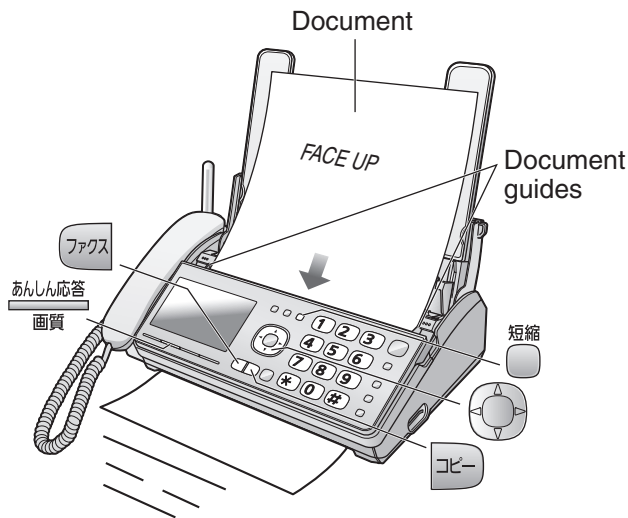

Cancel the voice guide features before sending a fax. (See page 10)

Sending a fax manually



- 1 Open the recording paper tray, and adjust the width of the document guides (blue) to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired resolution while “画質=” is displayed (see below).
- 4 Dial the fax number.
- 5 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing repeatedly while “画質=” is displayed.

To display “画質=”, press (Secure/Resolution).

画質=ふつう字	(Standard) for printed or typewritten originals with normal-sized characters.
画質=小さい字	(Fine) for originals with minute printing.
画質=写真	(Photo) for originals containing photographs.

Sending a fax using automatic dialing

Using the phonebook

- 1 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- 2 Press (Phonebook).
- 3 Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- 4 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Using the speed dialer

- 1 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- 2 Press (Speed dialer).
- 3 Press the memory station number (to).
- 4 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Copying documents

Cancel the voice guide features before copying a document. (See page 10)

- 1 Install the recording paper (see page 5).
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
 - If necessary, press (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired resolution while “画質=” is displayed (see above).
- 3 Press (Copy).
 - The unit will start copying.

Receiving faxes



You can select whether to receive faxes on recording paper or in memory.

Receive on recording paper : The received fax will be printed on recording paper. If an SD Memory Card is inserted, it will also be stored in the SD Memory Card. When the unit runs out of the recording paper or the ink film, the received fax will be stored in the main unit memory or the SD Memory Card.

Receive in memory : The received fax will be stored in the main unit memory or the SD Memory Card. To check the contents, print them. (You cannot check the contents on the display.)


■ To receive on recording paper

Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray beforehand.

■ To receive in memory

Remove the recording paper from the recording paper tray.

When new faxes are received in memory,

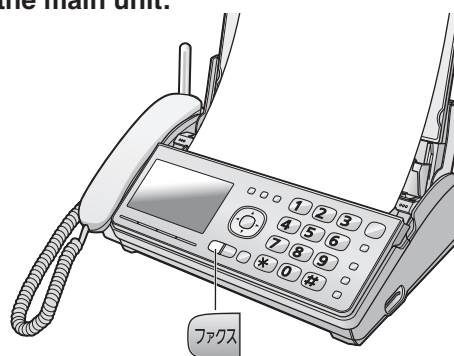
 (Caller ID log/Fax print indicator) will light on.


- It will also light on when a call is missed. (For Number Display service users.)
- If an SD Memory Card is inserted, new faxes will be received in the SD Memory Card.

When you want to print the received faxes, insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray, and print them.

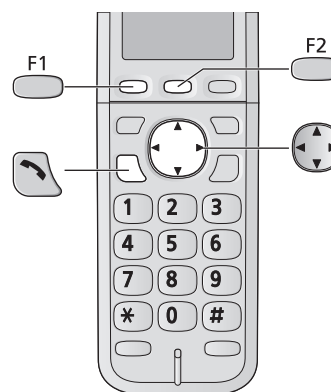
Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)






Using the main unit:



- 1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.
- 2 When:
 - document reception is required,
 - a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - no sound is heard,
 press  (Fax), then place the handset on the main unit.
 - The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset (KX-FKD504):



- 1 When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger, then press  (Talk) to answer the call.
- 2 When:
 - document reception is required,
 - a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - no sound is heard,
 press .
- 3 Press  (Search button) repeatedly until the “ファクス受信” is displayed, then press .
- 4 Press .
 - The main unit will start fax reception.

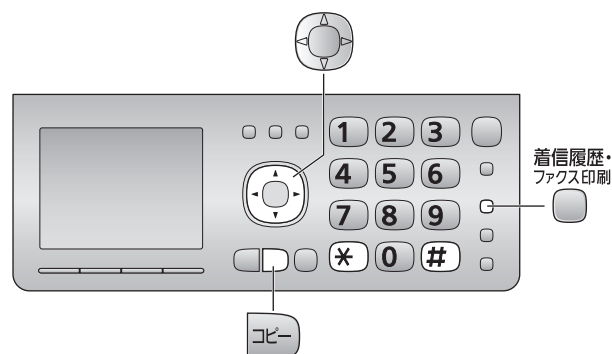
Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- 1 If the **留守** (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Printing all the new faxes received in the memory



When new faxes are received in memory, the following will be displayed.

Night mode

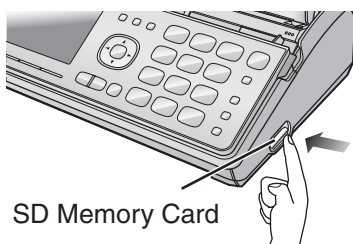
