## Installing the ink film

- 1 Open the control panel.

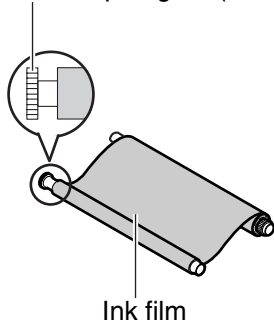

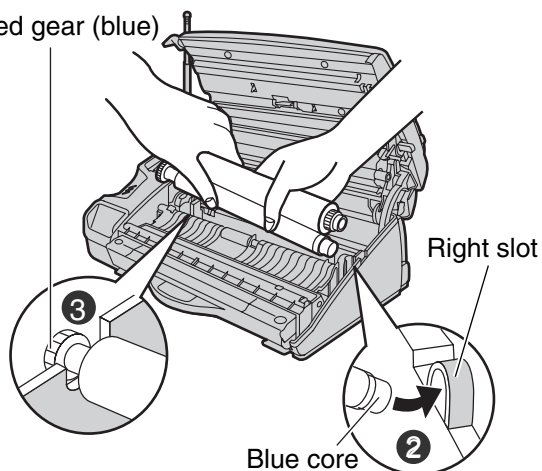

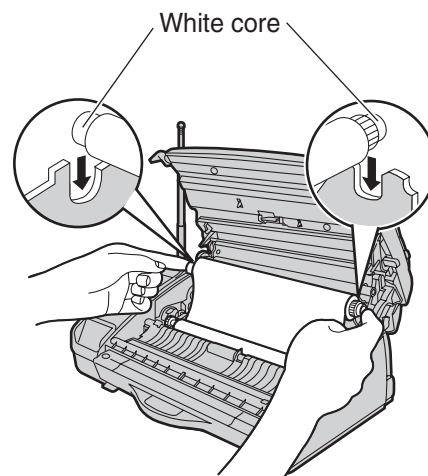
- 2 Insert the blue core into the right slot of the main unit.

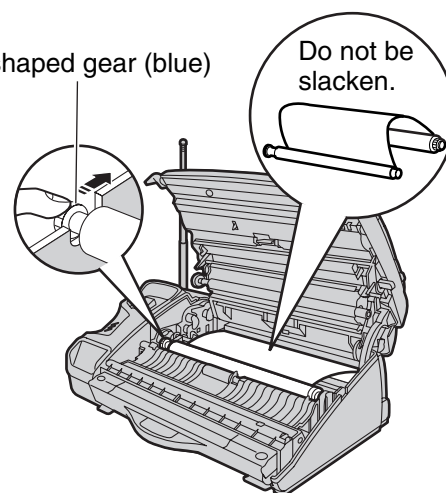
- 4 Insert the white core into the slots shown in the picture below.



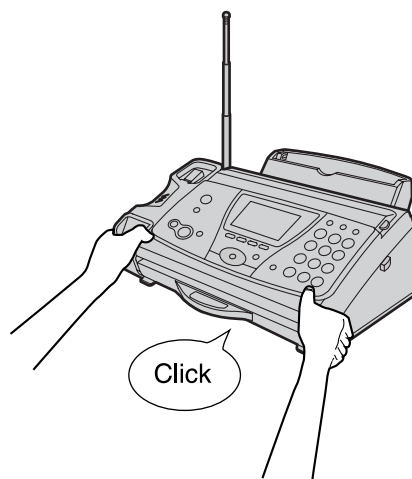
- 5 If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding the "T" shaped gear.

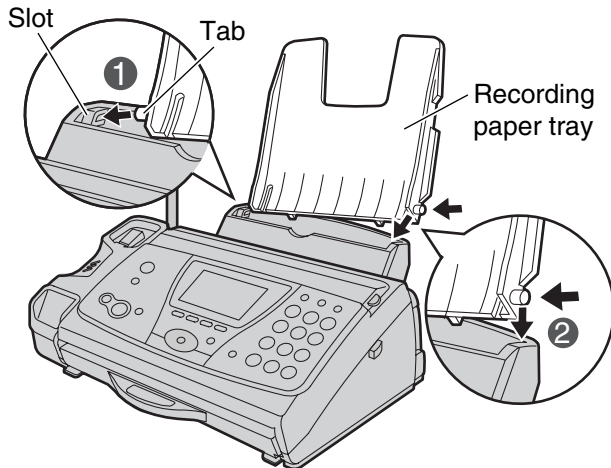

## Installing recording paper (A4 size)

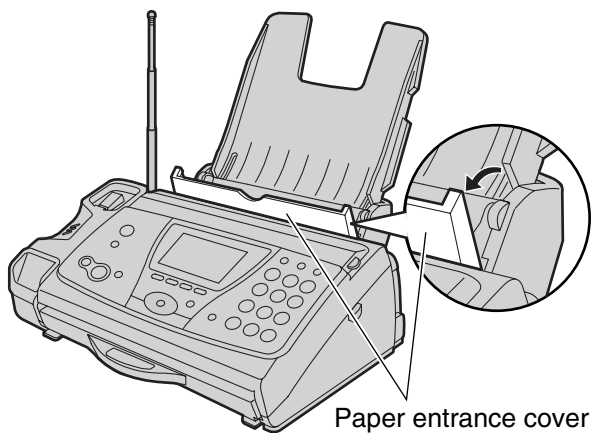
**1** Install the recording paper tray.

- 1 Insert the left tab on the recording paper tray into the left slot of the main unit.
- 2 Insert the right tab into the right slot of the main unit.



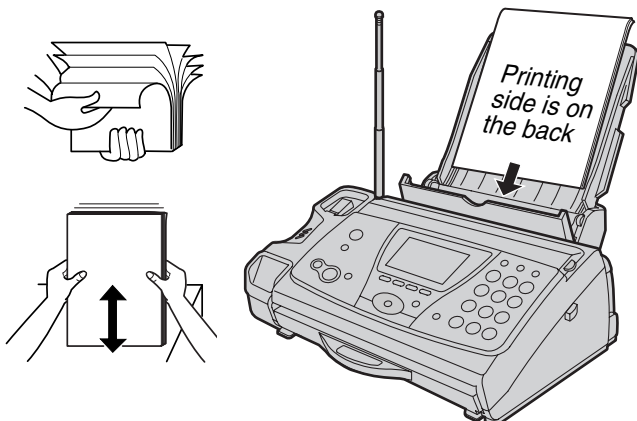
**2** Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray.

- 1 Open the paper entrance cover until it locks.

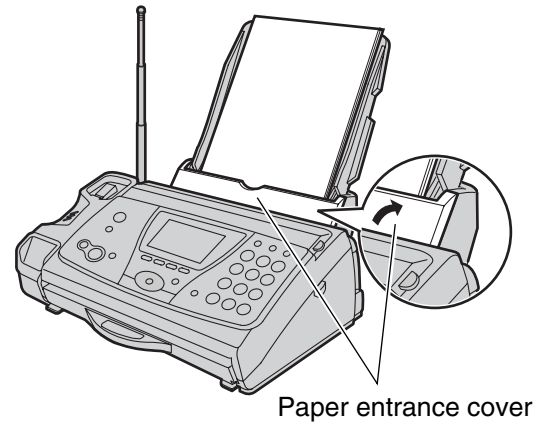


- 2 Fan the stack of recording paper (A4 size).

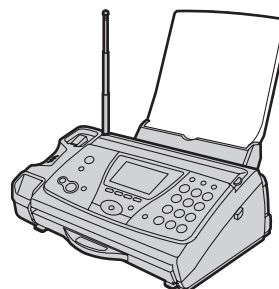
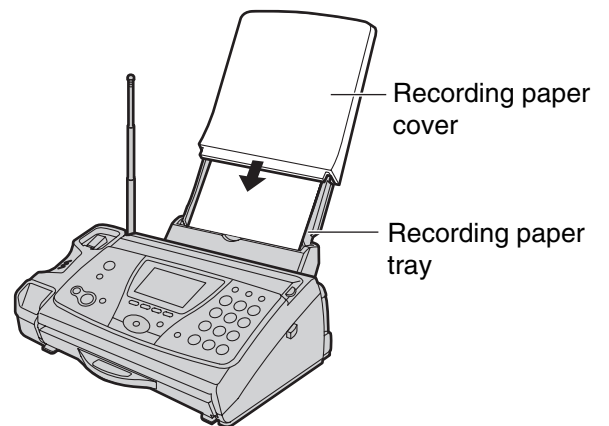
- 3 Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray. (Up to 30 sheets)



**3** Close the paper entrance cover by leaning it back.



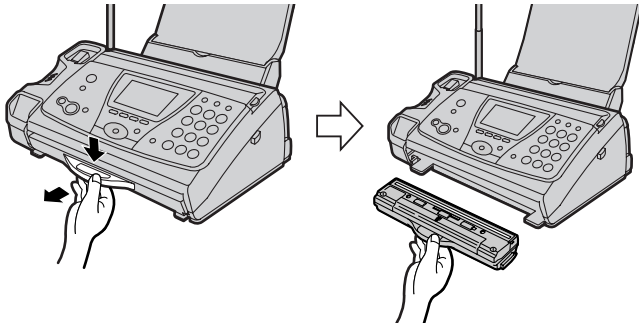
**4** Install the recording paper cover on the recording paper tray by sliding it down from the top.




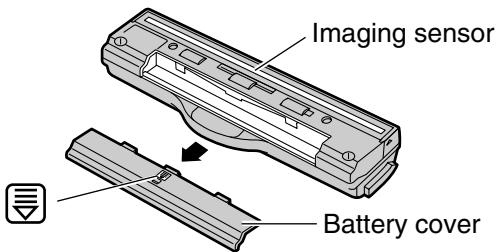

## Setting up the hand scanner

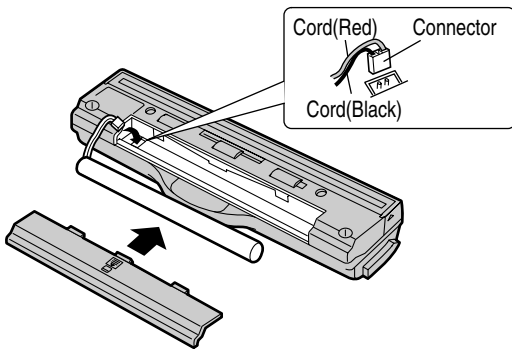
- 1** Press down the knob of the hand scanner, and pull out the hand scanner from the main unit.



- 2** Slide and open the battery cover by slightly pushing  part.

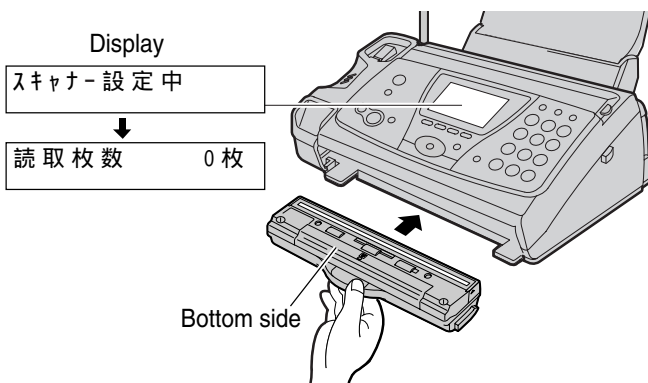


- 3** Connect the battery to the hand scanner, and close the battery cover.




- 4** Insert the hand scanner into the main unit.


- Charge the battery **for 10 hours** after connecting the power cord to the power outlet.



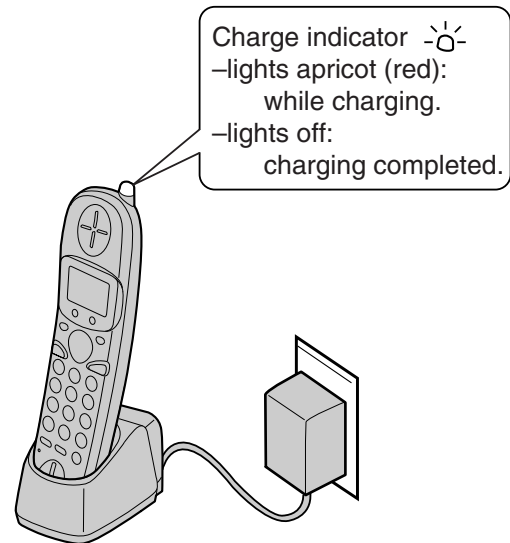
- The hand scanner battery is charged when the hand scanner is inserted into the main unit.

- 4** Lift the handset or press  (Speakerphone).
- 5** Dial the fax number.
- 6** When a fax tone is heard, press  (Fax).
- 7** Replace the handset if you are using it.
  - The unit will start fax transmission.

## Sending a fax using the phonebook



- 1** Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2** Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3** If necessary, press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4** Press  (Phonebook).
- 5** Press  (Search button) until the desired name is displayed.
- 6** Press  (Fax).
  - The unit will start fax transmission.

### To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing  (Resolution).

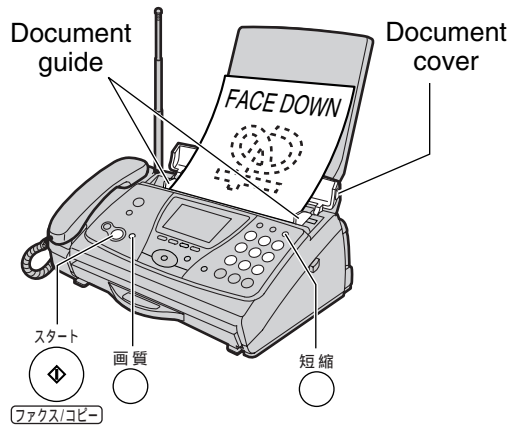



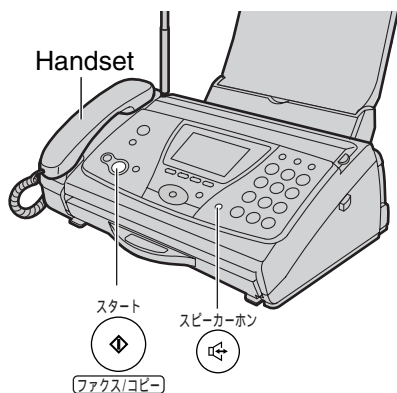

- 4** Press  (Speed dialer).
- 5** Press memory station number (① to ⑨).
- 6** Press  (Fax).
  - The unit will start fax transmission.

# Receiving faxes

## Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:

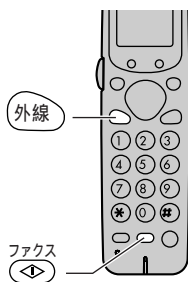


**1** When you hear a ring, lift the handset or press (Speakerphone) to answer the call.

**2** When:  
 – document reception is required,  
 – a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or  
 – no sound is heard,  
 press (Fax).

**3** Replace the handset if you are using it.  
 • The unit will start fax reception.

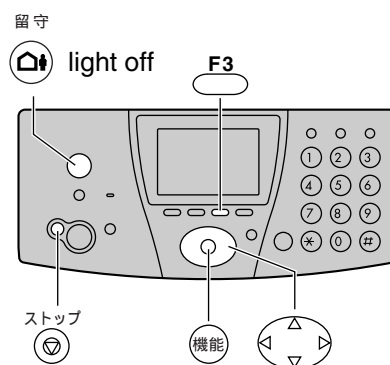
Using the portable handset:



**1** When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.  
 • If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).

**2** When:  
 –document reception is required,  
 –a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or  
 –no sound is heard,  
 press (Fax reception).  
 • The main unit will start fax reception.

## Setting ANSWER mode



If the (Auto answer) light is on, turn it off by pressing .

When AUTO ANSWER mode is off, the unit provides two types of receiving modes: “電話優先” (Telephone) mode and “ファクス優先” (Fax/Telephone) mode.

**Telephone mode (電話優先)** –Pre-selected setting:  
 Select this mode when you plan to answer the calls yourself.  
 When receiving calls, you have to answer all calls manually.

**Fax/Telephone mode (ファクス優先):**  
 Select this mode when you are near the unit and want to use it to receive voice calls yourself and fax calls automatically.

Change the setting if you want to use this mode.

- Press (Function).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly until the following is displayed.
- Press (Set).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired mode.

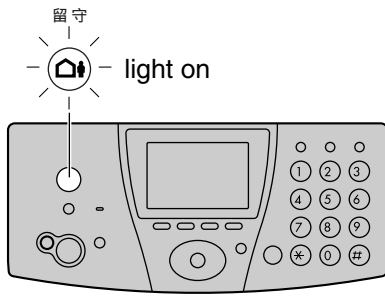

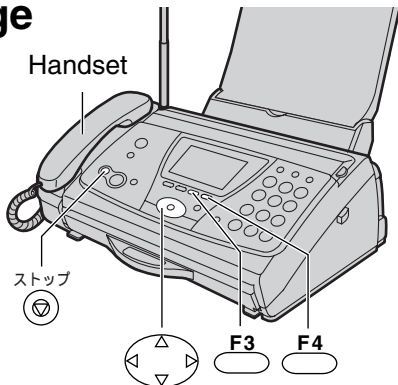
# Receiving faxes

## Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- 1 If the **留守** (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

## Recording your own greeting message

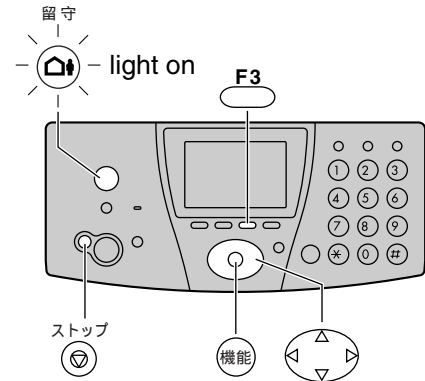


You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1 Press **留守電 F4** (Record).
- 2 Press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly until the following is displayed.

## Setting AUTO ANSWER mode



AUTO ANSWER mode will work when the **留守** (Auto answer) light is on.

AUTO ANSWER mode provides three types of receiving modes: “ファクス / 留守電” (Fax/Answering device) mode, “ファクス専用” (Fax only) mode and “留守電専用” (Answering device only) mode.

### Fax/Answering device mode (ファクス / 留守電)

–Pre-selected setting:

Select this mode when you want to receive all voice and fax calls automatically.

### Fax only mode (ファクス専用):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a fax machine.

### Answering device only mode (留守電専用):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a telephone answering device.

Change the setting if you want to use the fax only mode or answering device only mode.

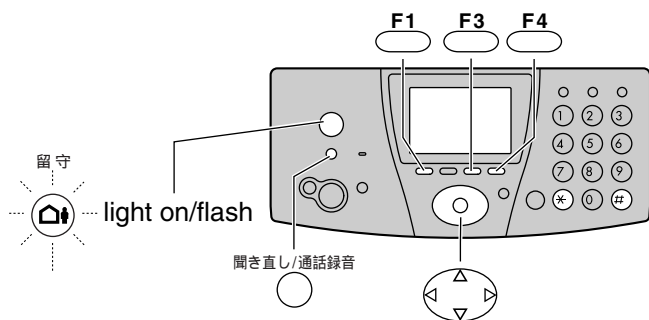

## Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the **留守** (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press **留守** to listen to recorded messages. After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

## Listening to all of the recorded messages

## Erasing a specific message

Press **消去 F1** (Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press **\***.

## Erasing all of the recorded messages

## Erasing your own greeting message

- 1 Press **留守電 F4** (Record), then press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly until the following is displayed.

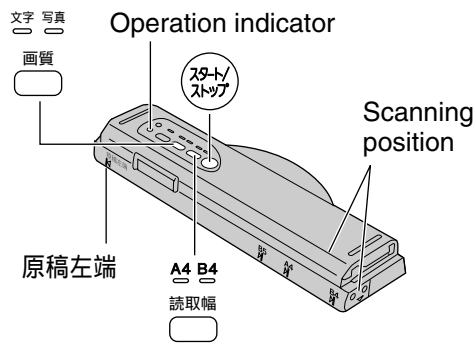
**Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location**

Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

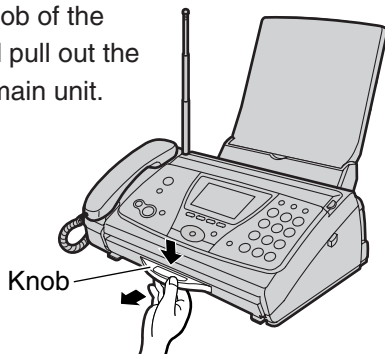
1. Call your unit.
2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
3. Press **2** or wait 4 seconds.
  - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
  - To listen to all the recorded messages, press **4** after the new messages have been played back.

# Using the hand scanner

## Scanning a document



- 1** Press down the knob of the hand scanner, and pull out the scanner from the main unit. Then, turn it over.



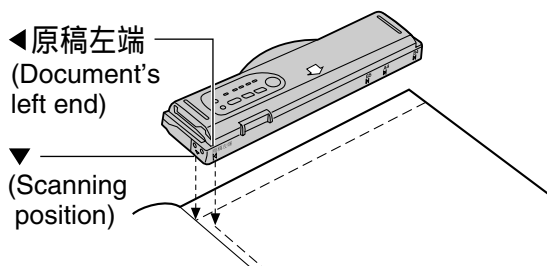
- 2** Press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired resolution.

- Resolution types
  - 文字 (Letter: For documents that consist of letters)

- 3** Press  (Scanning width) repeatedly to select the desired width.

  - A4 (Within 208mm)
  - B4 (Within 252mm)

- 4** Place the scanning position and the 原稿左端 (Document's left end) on the document.

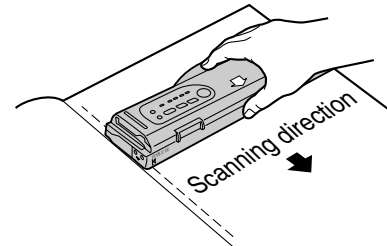


- 5** Press  (Start/Stop).

- You will hear a beep, and the operation indicator will light green after about 1 or 2 seconds. You can start scanning after the operation indicator lights green.

- 6** Press the hand scanner against the document, and move it slowly towards the direction of the arrow (⇩).

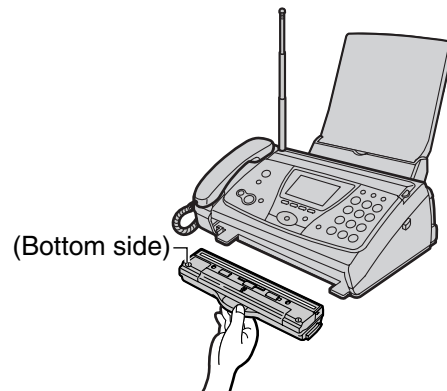
- When it is scanning properly, the operation indicator will flash green.
- For the proper scanning speed for different resolution types, see “Scanning speed and memory capacity” on the bottom of this page.



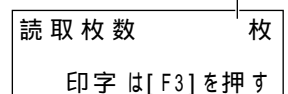
- 7** After scanning the document, press

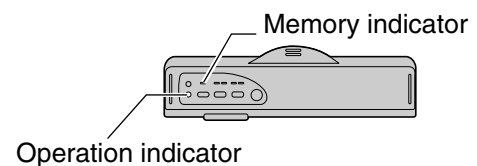
When scanning documents, check the operation indicator light.

Operation Indicator	Warning Beep	Situation
Green light Slow flash	No beep	The document is being scanned properly. (Fine letter mode)
Green light Fast flash	No beep	The document is being scanned properly. (Standard letter mode)
Green light ON	No beep	The hand scanner has temporarily stopped during scanning. You did not move the hand scanner for more than 30 seconds, so it has stopped scanning automatically.
Red light ON	No beep	The hand scanner is being moved quickly. (The document is being scanned.)
Red light ON	1 beep	The hand scanner is being moved too quickly. (Some parts of the document may not be scanned, or the scanned contents may be too compressed.)
Light OFF	3 beeps	The scanner memory is full. (The memory indicator green light will flash fast.)
		You have scanned a document that is more than 1.5 m in length as 1 page. Scan the document as 2 pages or more.
Light OFF	No beep	The scanner is not in operation.

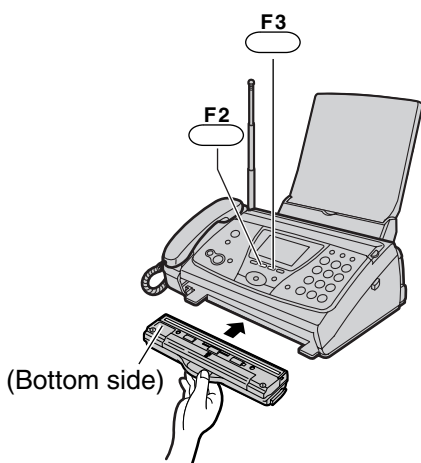

# Individual e-mail services

## Using the e-mail services

Kyushu Matsushita Electric Co., Ltd. (hereafter called "KME") offers individual information services, such as e-mail.

Your fax machine with e-mail features will enable you to send an e-mail to another party's personal computer (PC) or another e-mail fax machine anywhere in the world through the Internet. Also, you will be able to receive an e-mail from them.

To access the Internet using your fax machine,

- you need a credit card (VISA, JCB or MASTER as of February 2002) and
- have to subscribe to individual information services offered by KME beforehand.

The application fee including call charges will be charged to your Credit Card.

### Important:

- If your fax machine is connected to a home telephone system or a private branch exchange (PBX) system, these services are not available.

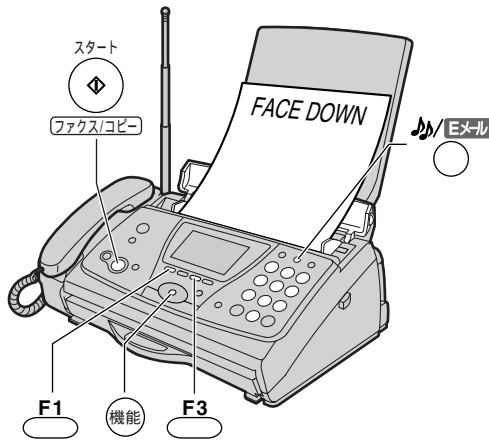

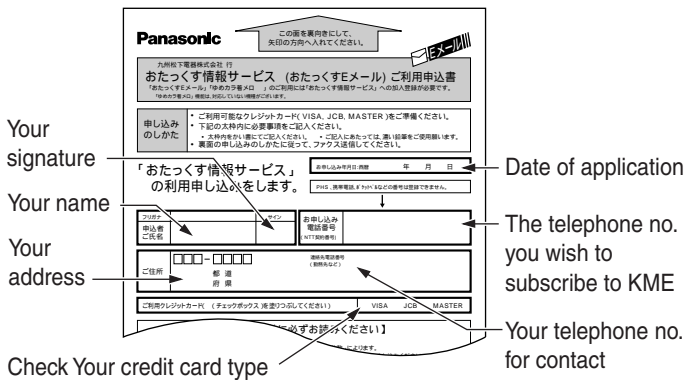

  - TIFF viewer software
  - WAV sound player software and sound system
