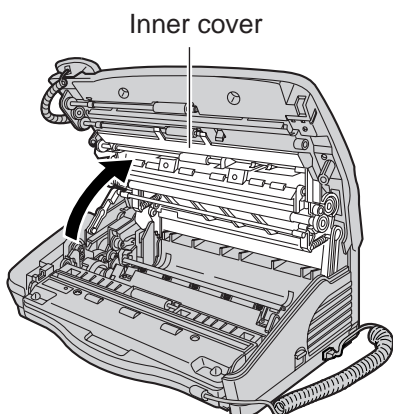


Installing the film cassette

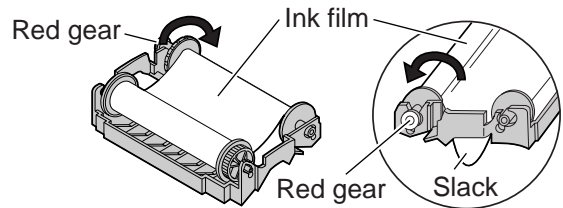
- 1** Press down the control panel open lever (①) and pull up the control panel. Press down the inner cover open lever (green) in the direction shown by the arrow (②).



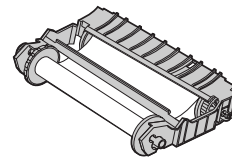
- 2** Open the inner cover.



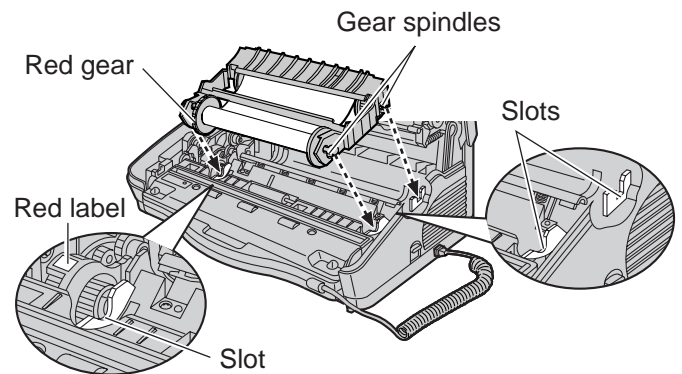
- 3** Prepare the film cassette.

 - If there is any slack in the ink film, tighten the film by rotating the gear.



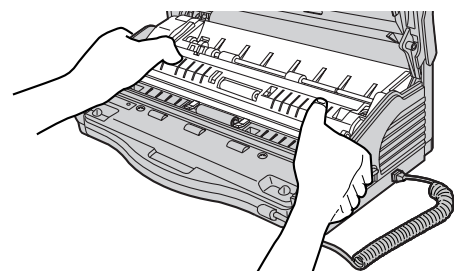
- Turn over the film cassette.



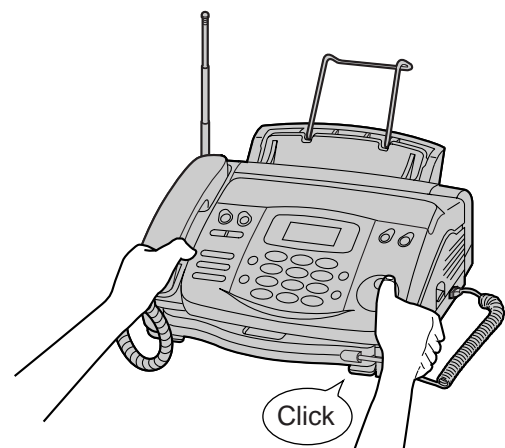
- 4** Put the film cassette into the main unit.



- 5** Close the inner cover by pressing down the parts firmly on both sides of the inner cover.



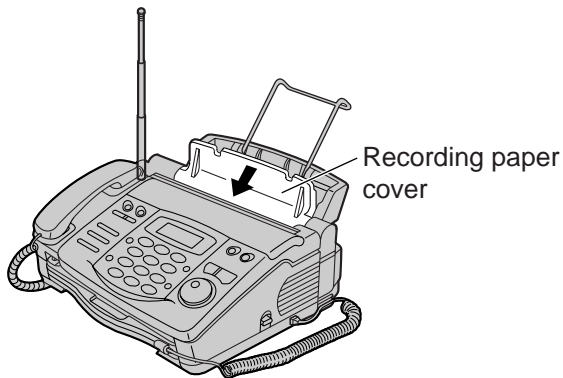

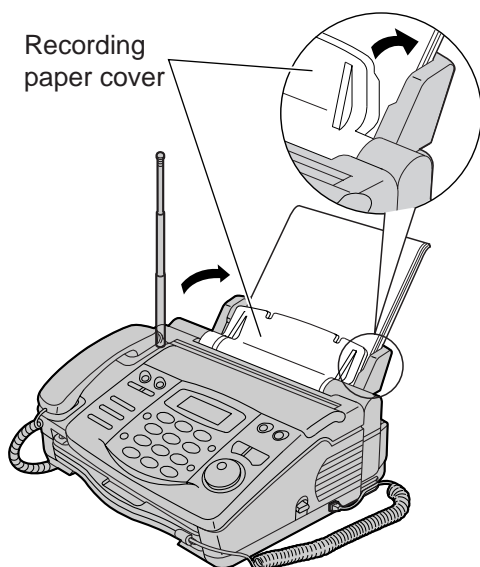



Sending a fax manually




- 1 Open the document tray, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Lift the handset or press  (Speakerphone).
- 5 Dial the fax number.
- 6 When a fax tone is heard, press  (Start).
- 7 Replace the handset if you are using it.
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Sending a fax using the search dial



- 1 Open the document tray, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Rotate the  (Search dial) until the desired name is displayed.
- 5 Press  (Start).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

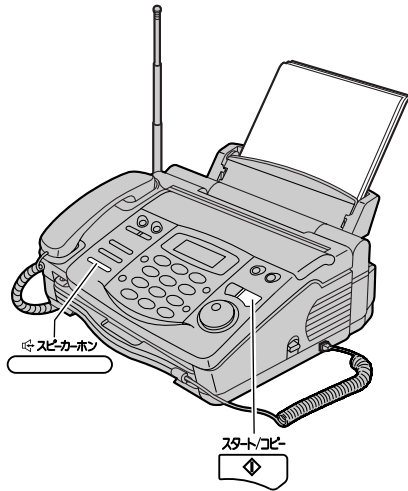

Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)



Using the main unit:

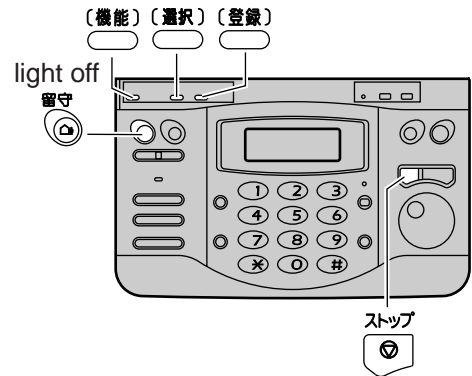
- 1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset or press (Speakerphone) to answer the call.
- 2 When:
 - document reception is required,
 - a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - no sound is heard,
 press (Start).
- 3 Replace the handset if you are using it.
 - The unit will start fax reception.



Using the portable handset:

- 1 When you hear a ring, press (Talk) or (Speakerphone) to answer the call.
- 2 When:
 - document reception is required,
 - a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - no sound is heard,
 press (Fax reception).
 - The main unit will start fax reception.

Setting AUTO ANSWER mode to off



If the (Auto answer) light is on, turn it off by pressing .

When AUTO ANSWER mode is off, the unit provides two types of receiving modes: “テ`ンワユセン” (Telephone) mode and “FAX ヲセン” (Fax/Telephone) mode.

Telephone mode (テ`ンワユセン) –Pre-selected setting:

Select this mode when you plan to answer the calls yourself. When receiving calls, you have to answer all calls manually.

Fax/Telephone mode (FAX ヲセン):

Select this mode when you are near the unit and want to use it to receive voice calls yourself and fax calls automatically.

Change the setting if you want to use this mode.

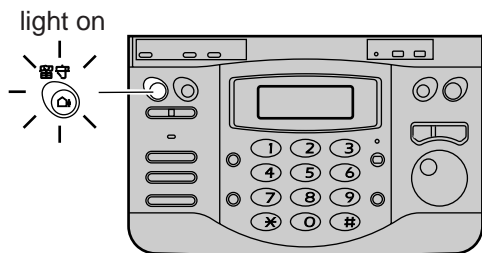

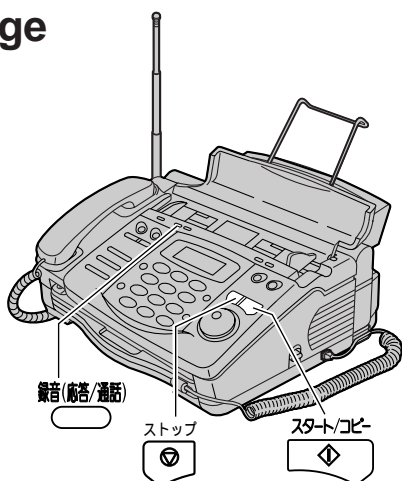
Receiving faxes

Automatic reception



- 1 If the **留守** (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

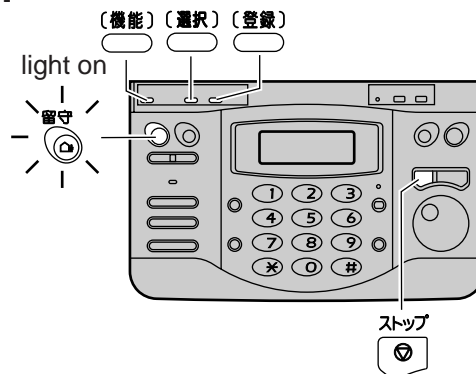
Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1 Press **録音(応答/通話)** (Record).
- 2 Lift the handset.
- 3 Press **スタート/コピー** (Start).
- 4 Record your greeting message, up to 16 seconds, using the handset.
- 5 Press **ストップ** (Stop).
- 6 Replace the handset.
 - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

Setting AUTO ANSWER mode to on



AUTO ANSWER mode will work when the **留守** (Auto answer) light is on.

AUTO ANSWER mode provides three types of receiving modes: "FAX / ルス^テ^ン" (Fax/Answering device) mode, "FAX センヨウ" (Fax only) mode and "ルス^テ^ンセンヨウ" (Answering device only) mode.

Fax/Answering device mode (FAX / ルス^テ^ン)

–Pre-selected setting:

Select this mode when you want to receive all voice and fax calls automatically.

Fax only mode (FAX センヨウ):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a fax machine.

Answering device only mode (ルス^テ^ンセンヨウ):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a telephone answering device.

Change the setting if you want to use the fax only mode or answering device only mode.

2. Press **☎120**.

means "Fax/Answering device mode" — **ルス = FAX / ルス^テ^ン [センタク, トウロク]**

3. Press **選択** (Select) repeatedly.

means "Fax only mode" — **ルス = FAX センヨウ [センタク, トウロク]**

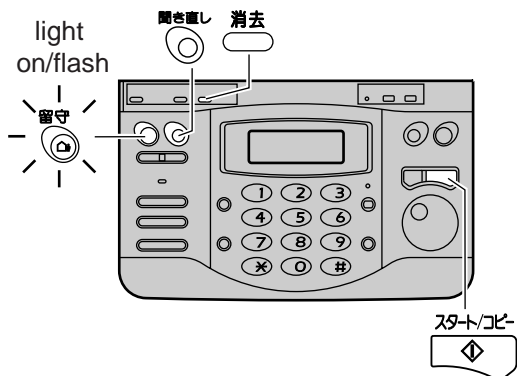
means "Answering device only mode" — **ルス = ルス^テ^ンセンヨウ [センタク, トウロク]**

Operating the built-in answering device

Activating the answering device



- 1 Turn the (Auto answer) light on by pressing .
- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
 - To record your own greeting message, see page 12.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press to listen to recorded messages.

Listening to all of the recorded messages

Press (Replay).

Erasing a specific message

- 1 Press (Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase.
- 2 Press (Start).

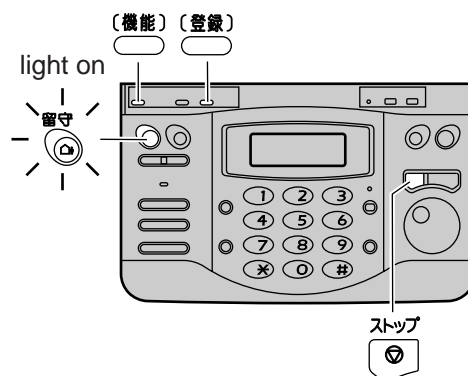
Erasing all of the recorded messages

- 1 Press (Erase).
- 2 Press (Start).

Erasing your own greeting message

- 1 Press (Erase) twice.
- 2 Press (Start).
 - The pre-recorded Japanese greeting message will be played when you receive a call.

Operating the answering device from a remote location



Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

1. Press (Function).
2. Press .
3. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except * or #.
4. Press (Register).
5. Press (Stop).

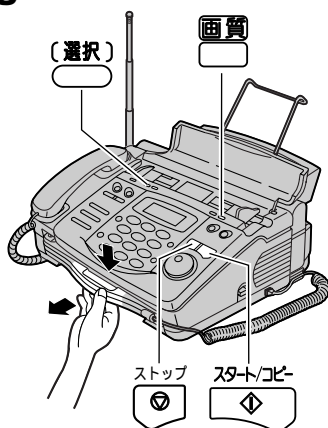
Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.


1. Call your unit.
2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
3. Press or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press after the new messages have been played back.

Operating the hand scanner


Scanning a document



1 Press down the handle of the hand scanner, and pull out the scanner from the main unit. Then, turn over the scanner to start scanning.

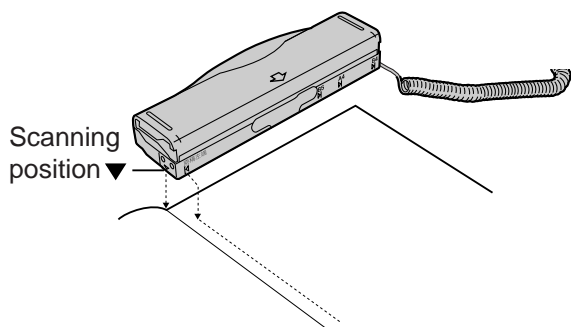
2 Press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired resolution.



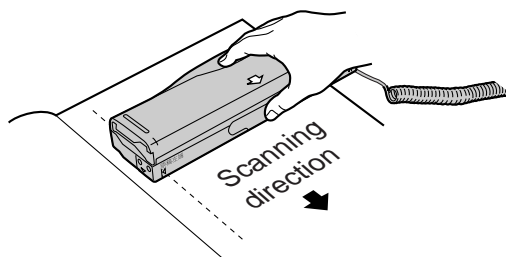
4 Place the scanning position on the upper left side of the document.



5 Press  (Start).

- When you hear a beep, you can start scanning.


6 Press the hand scanner against the document, and move it slowly toward the direction of the arrow.



7 After scanning is completed, press  (Stop).

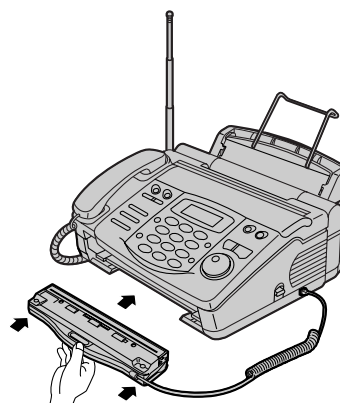
- You will hear a beep, and the scanned document is stored in memory of the main unit. Only 1 page can be scanned.

8 To print the scanned document or to send it by fax, see the next page.

- If you make a mistake, press  (Stop) to erase the content of the memory, then start from step 2.

Important:

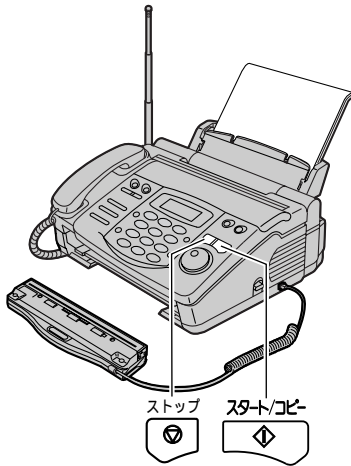
- When you have completed scanning, the scanned document in memory will be automatically erased after 10 minutes.
- To reinsert the hand scanner into the main unit, turn the scanner over, and insert it into the main unit firmly.



- When the hand scanner is out of the main unit, you cannot make a copy or send a fax.

Individual e-mail services

Using the e-mail services

Kyushu Matsushita Electric Co., Ltd. (hereafter called "KME") offers individual information services, such as e-mail.

Your fax machine with e-mail features will be able to send an e-mail to another party's personal computer (PC) or another e-mail fax machine through the Internet all over the world. Also, you will be able to receive an e-mail from them.

To access the Internet using your fax machine, you have to subscribe to the following services beforehand.

- -ALPHA5 services offered by the DDI, and
- Individual information services offered by KME.

See pages 17 and 18 to subscribe to these services. You must subscribe to the DDI services first, then the KME services.

Important:

- If your fax machine is connected to a home telephone system or a private branch exchange (PBX) system, these services are not available.

- KME plans to add new information services and the information service fee is subject to change. KME will announce them by e-mail to its customers.
- For the other party to view your fax e-mail or to hear your voice e-mail sent from your fax machine, the following PC software will be required.
 - E-mail software that can read the MIME format
 - TIFF viewer software
 - WAV sound player software and sound system

Subscribing to DDI -ALPHA5 services

To use the e-mail service, you have to subscribe to DDI first. If you filled out a DDI registration at the place where you purchased your fax machine, steps 1 and 2 below are not required.

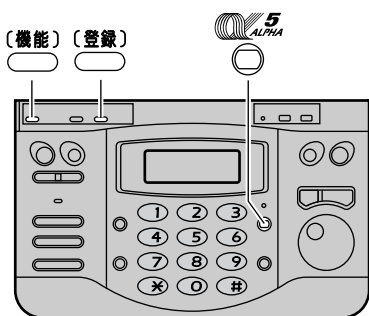

 - You can enter the address by rotating the (Search dial). To store an address, see page 22.
- 7 Press (Start).
 - The display will show the last title you entered. To delete this title, press (Clear) for 2 seconds more.
- 8 Enter the title of your fax e-mail, up to 32 characters (see the bottom of page 21 for instructions).
