

Finding the controls

Main unit (control panel)



- Voice select button adjusts the receiver tone quality.




Note:

If you use the portable handset near a microwave oven which is being used, noise may be heard from the earpiece or the speaker. Move away from the microwave oven and closer to the main unit.




Open the control panel and the back cover.






3 Insert the white core into the slots.




If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding the "T" shaped gear.




Installing recording paper (A4 size)

Install the recording paper tray.

1 Separate the recording paper cover from the recording paper tray.




- 2 Insert the left tab on the recording paper tray into the left slot of the main unit.

1 Open the paper entrance cover until it locks.




2 Fan the stack of recording paper (A4 size).









Intercom between the main unit and portable handset

An intercom is available between the main unit and portable handset.

A 2-way intercom is available between 2 portable handsets.

(For KX-PW501DL users: An optional handset is needed when using this feature.)






Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually



- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- If necessary, press (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Dial the fax number.
- **5** Press אלפיל (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Sending a fax using automatic dialing



Using the one-touch dial

- Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- **2** Press the desired one-touch dial button (1 \bigcirc to 3 \bigcirc).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Using the phonebook

- Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 2 Press Press (Phonebook).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- **4** Press المركز (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing (Resolution).



Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

2 When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,

• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset:



- When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.
 - If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).

2 When:


- -document reception is required,
- -a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- -no sound is heard,

press (Fax reception) until a single beep is heard.

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Receiving faxes


Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- If the (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing .
- When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- Press (Function/Edit).
- **2** Press **# 1 4 7**.



- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press 🏵 .



Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

- 1. Press (Function/Edit).
- 2. Press # 0 0 6.
- 3. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID).
 - * and # cannot be used.

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- 3. Press 2 or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4 after the new messages have been played back.
