3 Flash button

(For call waiting service users.) Clear/Erase button

- 4 Auto Answer button & indicator
  - -light on: answering device activated.
  - —light off: used as a regular telephone.

#### 5 **Replay** button plays back

recorded messages.

Record button records telephone calls.

- 6 Intercom button
  - Character Input Mode button
- 7 Hold button

Call Memory button starts a search in the Number Display log.

- (For caller ID display service users.)
- **8 Tone** button switches to tone dialing.
- 9 Set button

Resolution button selects the resolution when faxing or copying.

- **10 Function** button initiates programming. Edit button
- 11 Stop button
- 12 Copy button starts copying.
- 13 Fax button starts faxing.

**3** Enter the name, up to 20 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions).

**4** Press **F1** twice.

5 Enter the telephone number, up to 24 digits.
To correct a mistake, press 2007-J (Clear).

**6** Press **6**.

**7** Enter the group number (1) to (9).

**8** Press **5**<sup>1</sup>.

• To program other items, repeat steps 3 to 8.

**9** Press (Off) to exit the program.

# Making a voice call using the phonebook



**2** Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

## **3** Press **F1**.

**4** Edit the name (see the table on page 9 for instructions).

• If you do not need to edit the name, skip to step 5.

**5** Press **5**.

### **b** Edit the kana.

• If you do not need to edit the kana, skip to step 7.

- 8 Enter the correct telephone number.
  - If you do not need to edit the telephone number, skip to step 9.

12 Press (Off) to exit the program.

### For single portable handset users

Press 🕬 (Intercom).

#### For multiple portable handset users

- (2) Call the main unit and/or portable handset(s) in the following ways:
  - To call a specific portable handset, press the portable handset number (1) to (6)) which you want to call.
  - To call the main unit, press 0.
  - To call the main unit and all the portable handsets, press Ӿ).

## Sending a fax manually



Open the control panel cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.

**2** Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.

**4** Dial the fax number.

**5** Press (Fax).

• The unit will start fax transmission.

# Sending a fax using automatic dialing



#### Using the phonebook

Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.

**3** Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

### 4 Press (Fax).

• The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing (Set/Resolution).

画質=ふつう

(Standard) for printed or typewritten originals with normal-sized characters.

画質=小さい

(Fine) for originals with minute printing.

画質=写真

(Photo) for originals containing photographs.

## **Receiving faxes**

# Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

#### Using the main unit:



When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

### **2** When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,

press (Fax), then replace the handset.

• The unit will start fax reception.

#### Using the portable handset (KX-FKN511):



- When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.
  - If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).

## 2 When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,
- press  $\bigcirc$  until a single beep is heard.
- The main unit will start fax reception.

## **Receiving faxes**

# Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- If the প্রেক (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing প্রেক.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

# Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

### Activating the answering device





- **2** When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
  - To record your own greeting message, see page 15.

## Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press to listen to recorded messages. After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

 $\blacksquare$  To erase the messages, press  $(\bigstar)$

Press (Replay).

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To save the messages, press #



### Erasing a specific message

Press  $\bigcirc^{\substack{\pm\nu\nu\mathcal{F}\\ \not{} \cup \mathcal{F} - / \text{IR} \notin \mathbb{H}}}$  (Flash/Clear/Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press .

# Operating the answering device from a remote location



#### Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

- **1.** Press (Function/Edit).
- **2.** Press **#**006.
- Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except × or #.

- 4. Press (Set/Resolution).
- 5. Press (Stop).

## Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- 3. Press 2 or wait 4 seconds.
  - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
  - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4 after the new messages have been played back.
