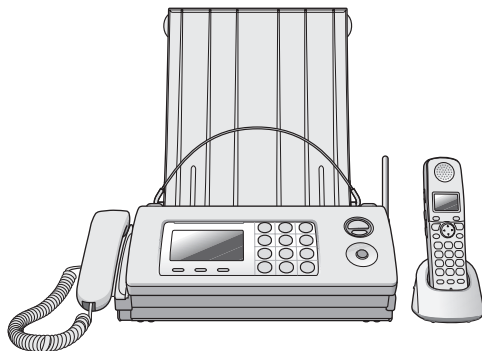

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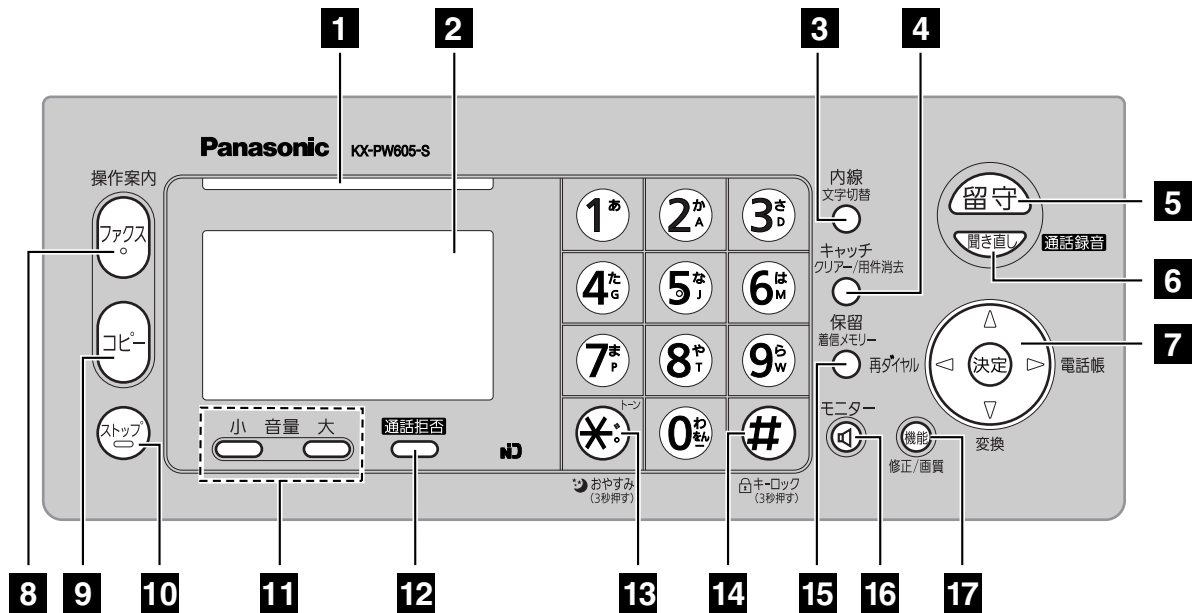

Finding the controls

Main unit



1 Call indicator

2 Liquid crystal display

3 Intercom button

Character Input Mode button

4 Flash button

(For call waiting service users.)

Clear/Erase button

5 Auto Answer button & indicator

—light on: answering device activated.

—light off: used as a regular telephone.

6 Replay button plays back recorded messages.

Record button records a telephone conversation.

7 Redial/Phonebook/Set key



To change Hiragana into Kanji.



To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.



To use the phonebook.



To store a parameter.

8 Fax button starts faxing.

9 Copy button starts copying.

10 Stop button

11 Volume button adjusts the volume.

12 Block button for the undesired call

13 Tone button switches to tone dialing.

Night mode button

14 Sharp button

Key lock button can lock the main unit so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.

- “**キーロック**” is displayed

- To turn key lock off, press this button for about 3 seconds.

15 Hold button

Call Memory button starts a search in the Number Display (Caller ID) log. (For Number Display service users.)

16 Monitor button

17 Function button initiates programming.

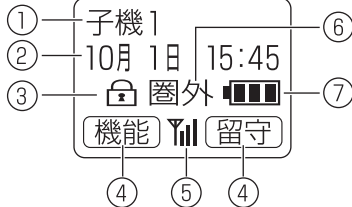

Portable handset (KX-FKN512)

Liquid crystal display



- ① Portable handset number (and name)
- ② Date and time (set by main unit)
- ③ Key lock is on
- ④ Function menu that is controlled by **F1** or **F2**
- ⑤ Link strength to the main unit
- ⑥ No link to the main unit
- ⑦ Battery strength

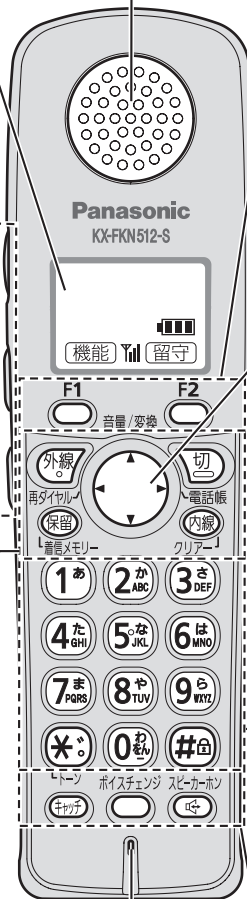

How to use **F1** **F2** buttons

- F1** and **F2** buttons refer to the function displayed on the bottom of the display. They function differently depending on the mode.

How to use **音量/変換** key

- To use the phonebook.
- To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.
- To adjust the volume.
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.

Dial buttons

- **トーン** (Tone button)
 - To switch to tone dialing.
- **シャープ** (Sharp button)
 - To lock the portable handset so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.
 - “**鍵外**” is displayed.
 - To turn key lock off, press this button for about 3 seconds.

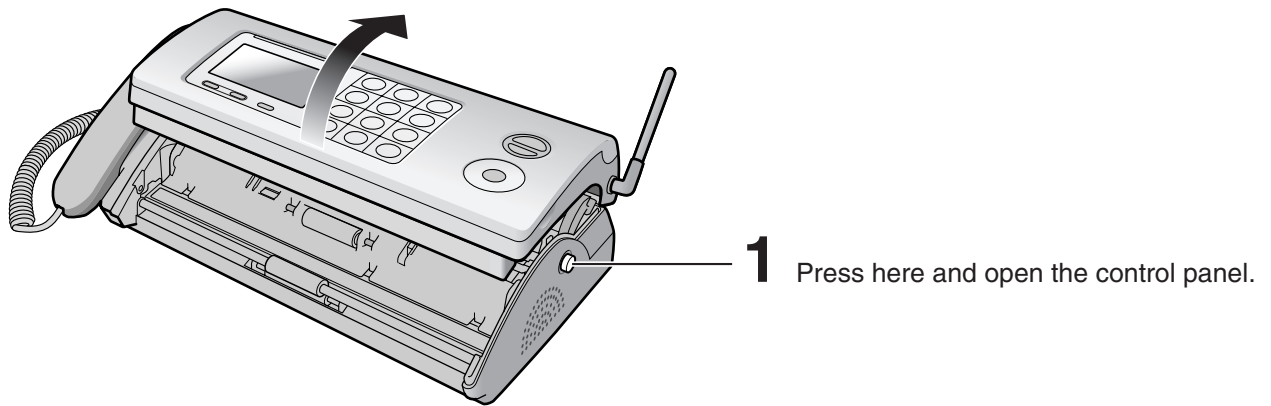
- **キルチ** (Call waiting)
 - For call waiting service users.

- **ボイスチェンジ** (Voice change)
 - To change your voice.
 - To mute your voice to the other party by pressing this button for about 2 seconds. (To release the mute, press this button again.)

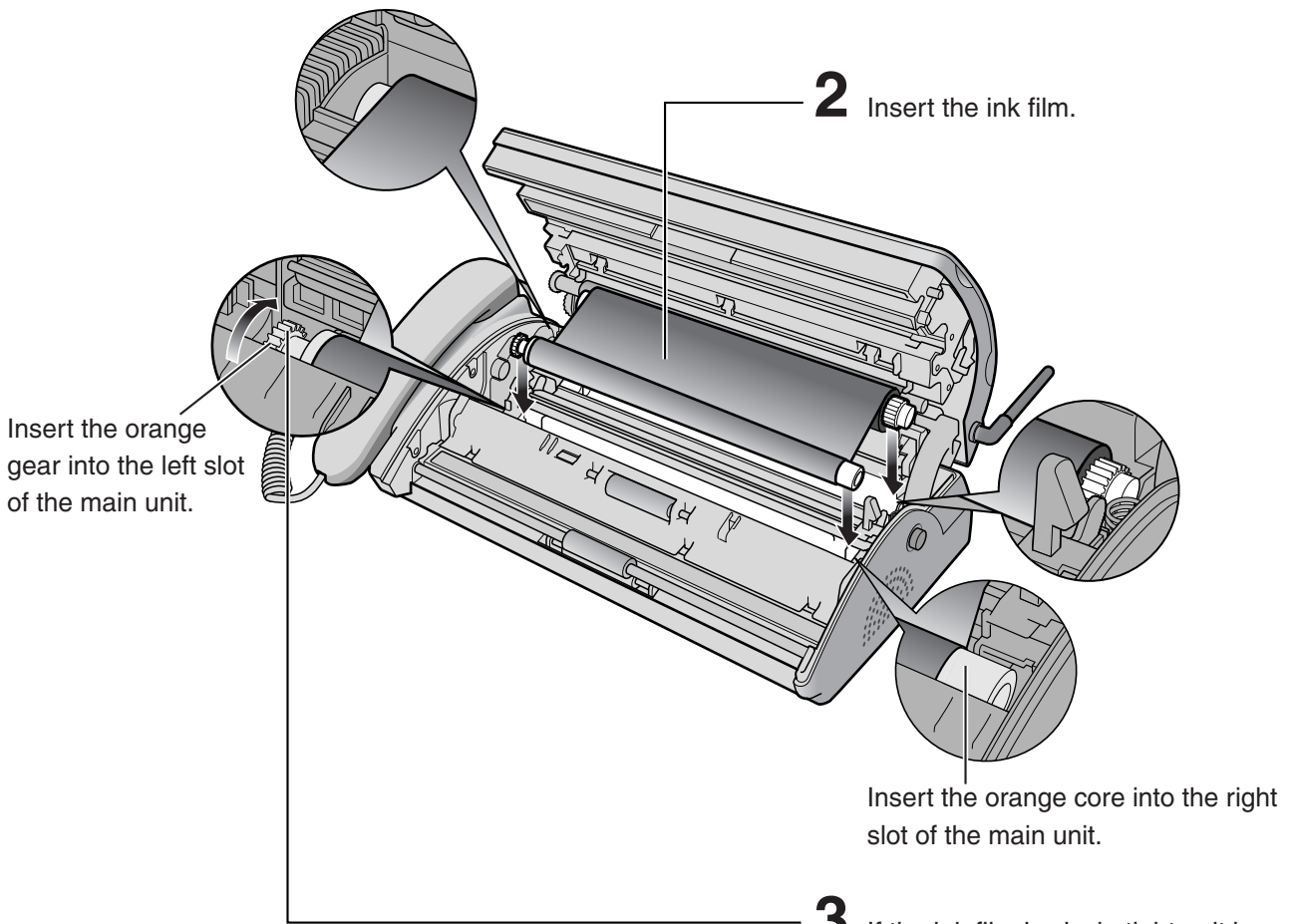
- **スピーカーホン** (Speakerphone)
 - To use the speakerphone.

Installations and connections

Installing the ink film



1 Press here and open the control panel.



2 Insert the ink film.

Insert the orange gear into the left slot of the main unit.

Insert the orange core into the right slot of the main unit.

3 If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding this gear (orange).

4 Close the control panel until it locks.

• When the unit runs out of ink film, the following message will be displayed.

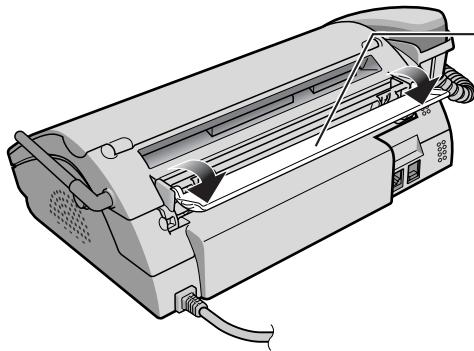

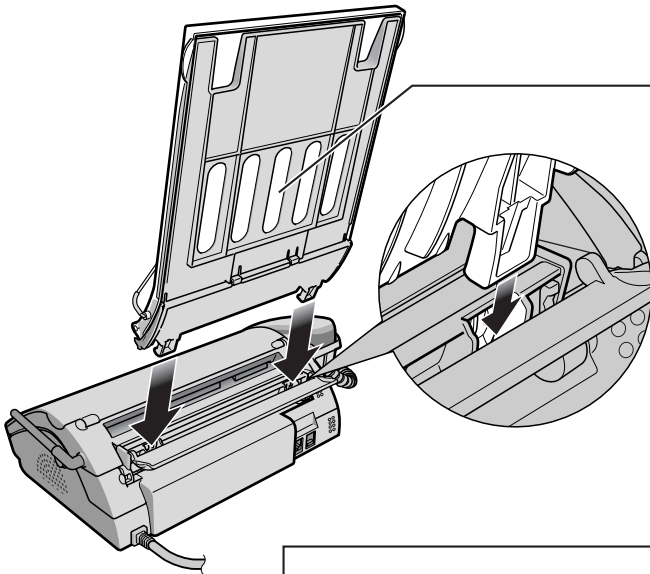

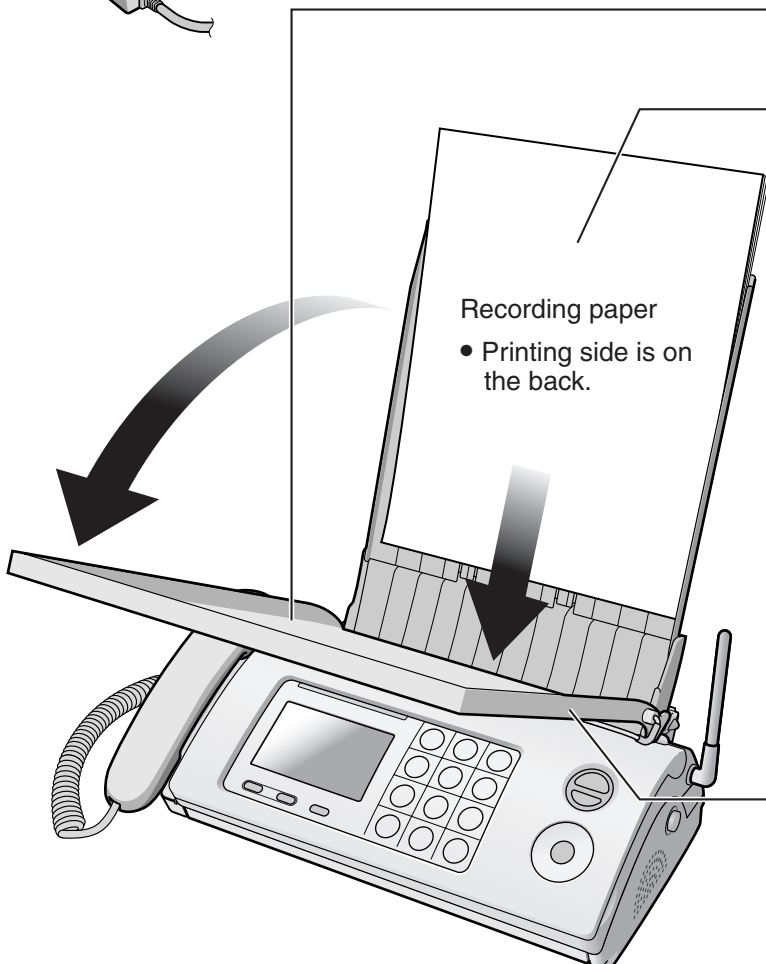

- 1** Open the recording paper insertion cover.



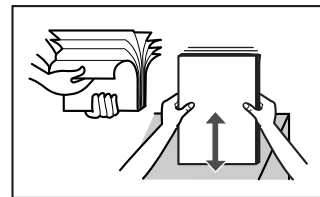
- 2** Install the recording paper cover/tray.

- 4** Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray. (Up to 20 sheets)

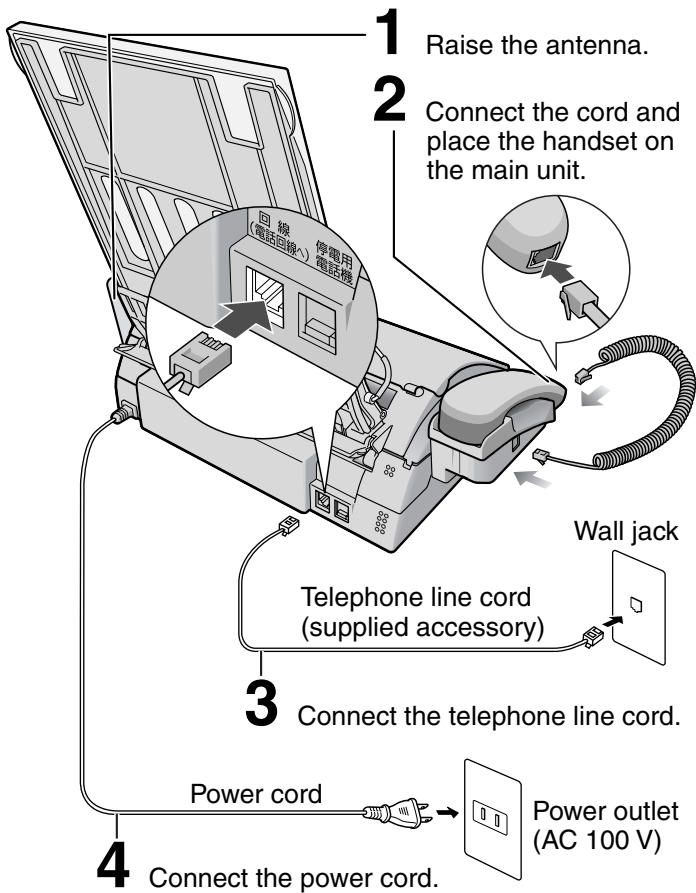
- Fan the stack of recording paper.

2. Press **# 0 7 9**.
3. Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired setting is displayed.

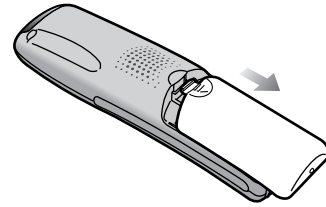

Error announcements

The unit can make an announcement to alert you when the following errors or trouble occurs:

- The control panel is opened while sending a fax or printing
- The recording paper runs out or jams
- The ink film runs out
- The document paper jams or does not eject properly

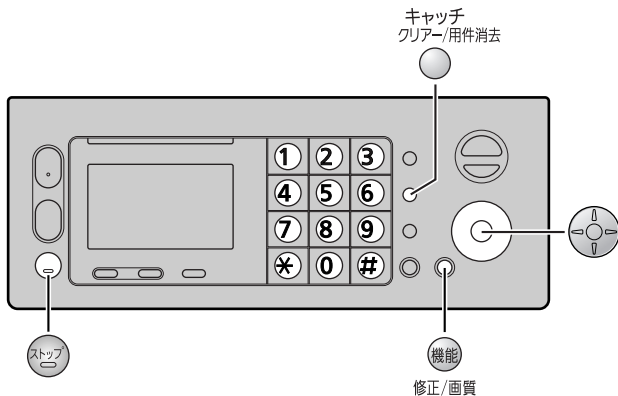

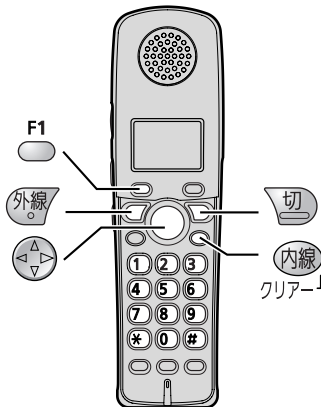

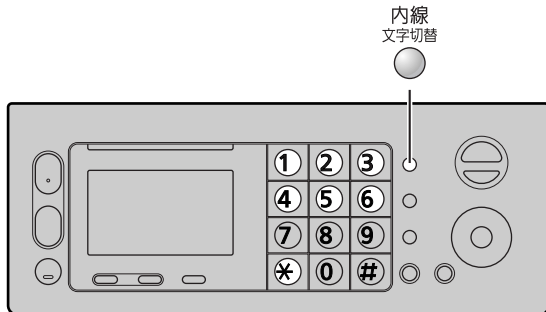

Intercom

An intercom is available between the portable handsets or between the main unit and portable handset(s).

Using the main unit:



1 ■ For single portable handset users



- ① Lift the handset.

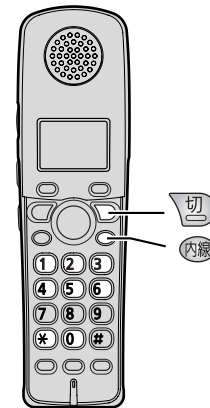

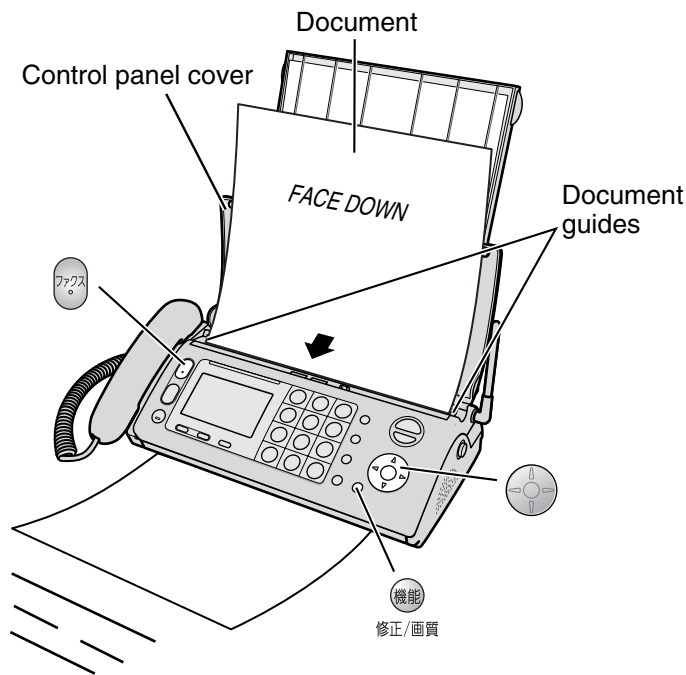

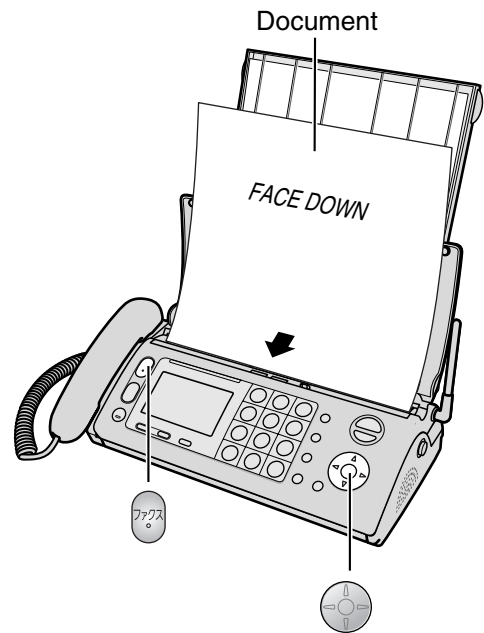
Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually



- 1** Open the control panel cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2** Press **ファクス** (Fax).
- 3** If necessary, press **機能 修正/画質** (Function/Edit/Resolution), press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired setting, then press **決定** (Set) (see below).
- 4** Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 5** Dial the fax number.
- 6** Press **ファクス** (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Sending a fax using the phonebook



- 1** Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 2** Press **電話帳** (Phonebook).
- 3** Press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- 4** Press **ファクス** (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing **機能 修正/画質** (Function/Edit/Resolution), then press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly.

- If you turn the operation guide off, press **機能 修正/画質** (Function/Edit/Resolution) 2 times, then press **検索** (Search button) repeatedly.

Press **決定** (Set) to decide the resolution.

画質=通常 [◀,▶,決定]押す (Standard) for printed or typewritten originals with normal-sized characters.

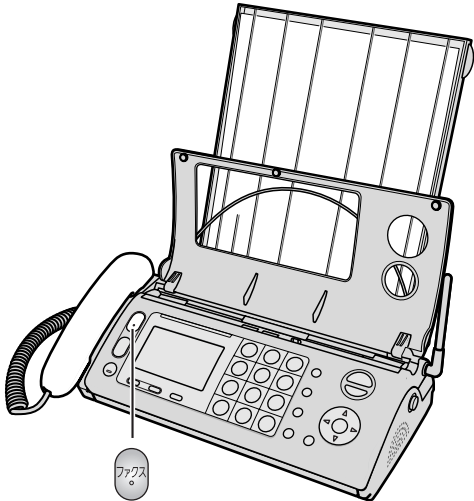

Receiving faxes


Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



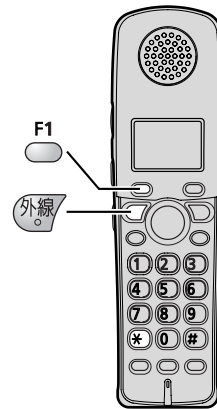
1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

2 When:
– document reception is required,
– a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
– no sound is heard,


press  (Fax), then replace the handset.


- The unit will start fax reception.


Using the portable handset (KX-FKN512):




1 When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.

- If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press  (Talk).

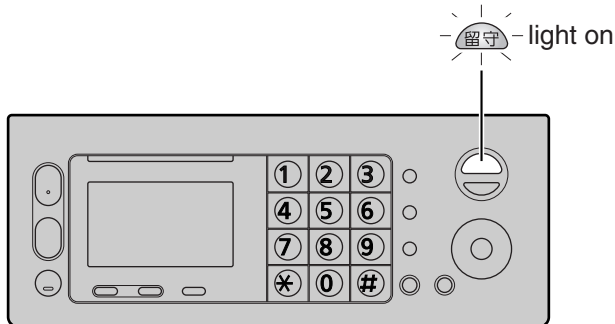
2 When:
– document reception is required,
– a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
– no sound is heard,
press .

3 Press  (Search button) repeatedly until the “ファクス受信” is displayed.

4 Press  2 times.
• The main unit will start fax reception.

Receiving faxes

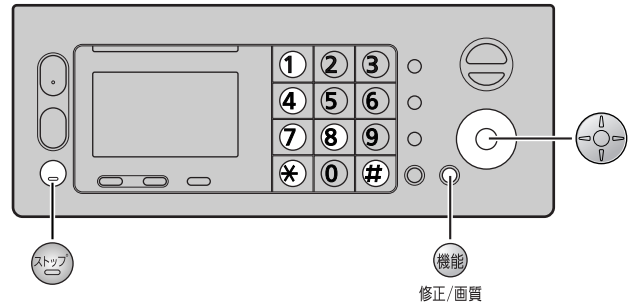
Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- 1 If the **留守** (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1 Press **機能** (Function/Edit/Resolution).
- 2 Press **# 1 4 7**.

- 4 Lift the handset.
- 5 Press **決定** (Set) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.
- 6 Press **ストップ** (Stop) and replace the handset.

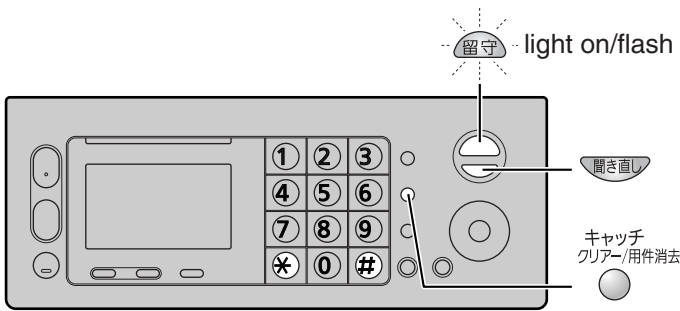

Operating the built-in answering device

Activating the answering device



- 1 Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
 - To record your own greeting message, see page 16.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the **留守** (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press **留守** to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press *****. 再生した用件を消去する=* しない=#
- To save the messages, press **#**.

Listening to all of the recorded messages

Press **聞き直し** (Replay).

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press *****. 再生した用件を消去する=* しない=#
- To save the messages, press **#**.

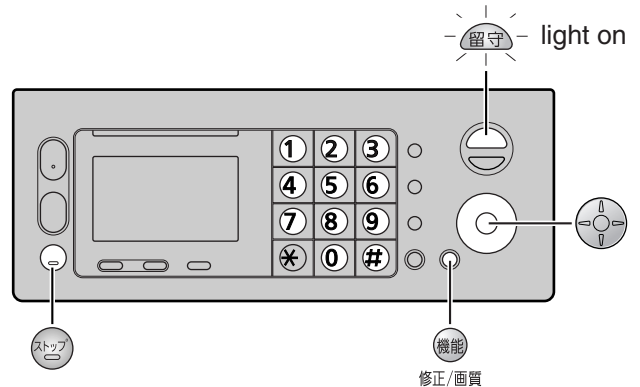
Erasing a specific message

Press **キャッチ クリアー/用件消去** (Flash/Clear/Eraser) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press *****.

Operating the answering device from a remote location



Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

1. Press **機能** (Function/Edit/Resolution).
2. Press **# 0 0 6**.
3. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except * or #.

4. Press **決定** (Set).
5. Press **ストップ** (Stop).

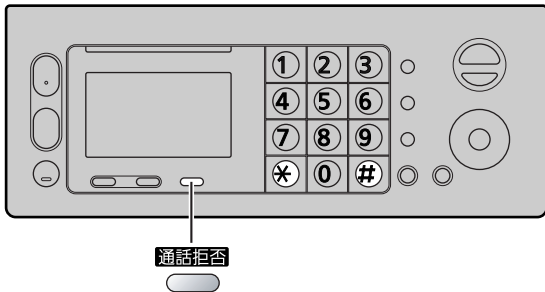
Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

1. Call your unit.
2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
3. Press **2** or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press **4** after the new messages have been played back.

Blocking the incoming calls

Using the main unit:



Press **通話拒否** (Block) while the unit is ringing or while you are on an incoming call.

- The unit announces a message to the caller 2 times, then hangs up automatically. The message is announced in Japanese and means “We’re sorry, but your call cannot be connected.”.

For Number Display service subscribers

If you subscribe to Number Display service, the message heard by the caller will change according to the caller’s situation.

Example :

If the caller requested not to send caller’s information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean
 “Your phone number is blocked by service provider.
 Please call again with adding ‘186’ to the beginning of the phone number.”.

When the following is displayed after pressing

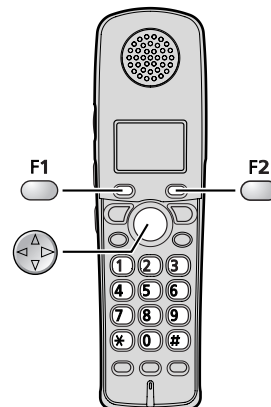

- The unit announces a message to the caller 2 times, then hangs up automatically. The message is announced in Japanese and means “We’re sorry, but your call cannot be connected.”.

For Number Display service subscribers

If you subscribe to Number Display service, the message heard by the caller will change according to the caller’s situation.

Example :

If the caller requested not to send caller’s information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean
 “Your phone number is blocked by service provider.
 Please call again with adding ‘186’ to the beginning of the phone number.”.

When the following is displayed after operating step 1 to 3, you can set the unit to block the call from the same telephone number.

- To block the call, press **F1**.
- To cancel blocking, press **F2**.

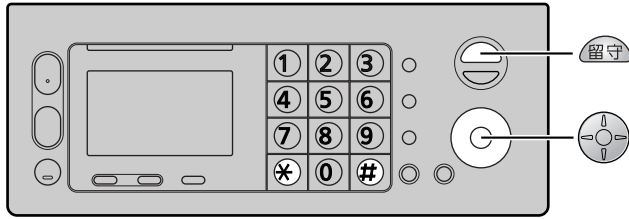

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- “” is displayed and lights on.
- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press . 再生した用件を消去
する=* しない=#
- To save the messages, press .

Printing received fax documents

When new faxes are received, the following will be displayed.

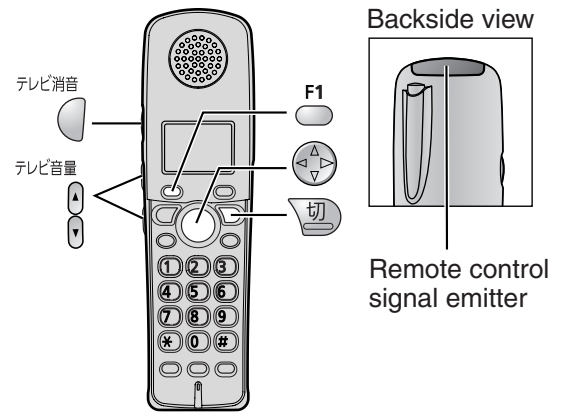

Preparation: Programming the maker of your TV

1. Press .

 - If you do not want to use this feature, please select “使用しない”.
