



Finding the controls

Main unit



- 1 Liquid crystal display
 - The display turns off after about 2 minutes of inactivity.
 - To turn on the display, press $\overset{\text{ZhyJ}^2}{\bigoplus}$ (Stop).
- 2 Speed Dialer button
- 3 Volume/Change/Redial/Phonebook key



- To adjust the volume.
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.



मुष्ट्राचा To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.



To use the phonebook.



To store a parameter.

- 4 Call/Fax List button starts a search in
 - the Number Display (Caller ID) log.
 - the fax list stored in memory.

Call/Fax List indicator lights when

- a call was missed. (For Number Display service users.)
- a fax was stored in memory.
- 5 Auto Answer button & indicator
 - —light on: answering device activated.
 - —light off: used as a regular telephone.

6 Playback button plays back recorded messages.

Record button records a telephone conversation.


- When an SD Memory Card is available, it is recorded in the SD Memory Card.
- 7 Intercom button
- 8 Power indicator
- 9 SD Memory Card cover
- 10 SD indicator
- **Multi-operation** buttons refer to the function displayed on the display panel.
- 12 Fax button starts faxing.
- 13 Copy button starts copying.
- 14 Stop button
- **Tone** button switches to tone dialing. Night mode button
- 16 **Sharp** button

Key lock button can lock the main unit so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.







 - If you do not need to edit the group number, skip to step 11.
- 11 Press ^{決定} (Set).
- 12 Press איין (Stop).

Automatic dialing on the main unit

Storing names and telephone numbers in the speed dialer

You can store up to 9 names and telephone numbers which are stored in the phonebook. The dialing buttons (1) to 9) function as memory stations.







Intercom

An intercom is available between the portable handsets or between the main unit and portable handset(s).






Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually



- Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- **3** If necessary, press 直复 (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Press (Fax).
- **5** Dial the fax number.
- **6** Press স্থ্য (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Sending a fax using automatic dialing



Using the phonebook

- Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- **2** Press 中電話帳 (Phonebook).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- 4 Press المراجع (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Using the speed dialer

- Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- **2** Press ^{短縮} (Speed dialer).
- **3** Press the memory station number (1) to (9)).
- **4** Press (ጉ/ጋ구) (Fax)
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

画質
Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing FZ (Resolution) repeatedly.

画質=ふつう字

(Standard) for printed or typewritten originals with normal-sized characters.

画質=小さい字

(Fine) for originals with minute printing.

画質=写真

(Photo) for originals containing photographs.

Receiving faxes

You can select beforehand whether to receive faxes by "Receive in memory" or "Receive on recording paper".

(Default setting)


Receive in memory: The received fax will be stored in the main unit memory. You can check the contents on the display, then print them if necessary.

Receive on recording paper : The received fax will be printed on recording paper.

■ Setting/canceling "Receive in memory"

Press \mathbb{R}^{0} (Receive in memory), then \mathbb{R}^{1} (Yes).

(Changes each time they are pressed.)



Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.


When:

- document reception is required,
- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,

press (७७७७) (Fax), then replace the handset.

• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset (KX-FKN515):



- When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.
 - If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press 外線 (Talk).



- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)




- If the 留守 (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing @守.
- $oldsymbol{2}$ When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.


Receiving faxes

Display when faxes are received in memory

- It will also light on when a call is missed.
 (For Number Display service users.)
- Even if an SD Memory Card is inserted, new faxes will be received in the main unit memory. (To save the faxes to the SD Memory Card, see page 22.)




Viewing faxes stored in memory



Information about display

■ To scroll display contents



The display contents can be scrolled up, down, left and right.





■ To enlarge or reduce content

Press $\frac{\Box \oplus \vec{\lambda} - \vec{\lambda}}{F2}$ (Turn/Zoom) $\frac{\vec{\lambda} - \vec{\lambda}}{F4}$ (Zoom) to enlarge or reduce the display content in the following order:

 $Normal \rightarrow Enlarge(double size) \rightarrow Reduce(half size) \rightarrow Normal \cdots$

■ Scroll pages


To show the next page: Press (Scroll page) 次ページ (Next page).





Receiving faxes

Printing a specific fax stored in memory



- Tess 着信・ファクス一覧 (Call/Fax list), then press <u>F4</u> (Fax list).
- **2** Press (Search button) to select the desired fax to print, then press [F3] (Print).
- After printing, the following is displayed.

- If you want to delete the fax, press ぱい (Yes).

4 Press ストップ (Stop).

Deleting a specific fax stored in memory

Press (Search button) to select the desired fax to delete.



Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- **1** Press 機能 (Function).
- **2** Press # 1 4 7.

- 4 Lift the handset.
- **5** Press 開始 (Start) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.
- **6** Press F3 (End) or ストップ (Stop) and replace the handset.
 - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.


- **1** Press 機能 (Function).
- **2** Press # 1 4 8.

Operating the built-in answering device

Activating the answering device



If an SD Memory Card is available(inserted), voice messages will be recorded to the SD Memory Card. (See page 22.)

- **1** Turn the ঞ্জি (Auto answer) light on by pressing ঞ্জিক).
- When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
 - To record your own greeting message, see page 18.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the 留守 (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press 留守 to listen to recorded messages.



Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

- ### 1. Press ### (Function).
- 2. Press # 0 0 6.
- 3. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except * or #.

- 4. Press 決定 (Set).
- **5.** Press (Stop).

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location


Turn the 留守 (Auto answer) light on before you go out.

Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- 3. Press 2 or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4 after the new messages have been played back.

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- "きまやす " is displayed and 留守 lights on.
- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the following will be displayed. 新しい用件が 録音されました

Press (Playback) to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed. 再生した用件を 消去しますか?

- To erase the messages, press [はい] (Yes).
- To save the messages, press (No).



Turn off the night mode

Press (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

Blocking the incoming calls

Using the main unit:



To block a call using a message

While the unit is ringing, press 通話拒否 (Block).

OR

While you are on an incoming call, press $\stackrel{\boxtimes EE}{=}$ (Block), then press $\stackrel{\stackrel{\triangle}{=}}{=}$ (Voice).

The unit announces a message to the caller
 2 times, then hangs up automatically. The message is announced in Japanese and means
 "We're sorry, but your call cannot be connected.".

To block a call using chimes

- ¶ While you are on an incoming call, press 通話拒否 (Block).
- **2** Press $\frac{f + 7}{6}$ (Chime).
 - Chimes are heard by the caller.
- 3 Tell the caller that a visitor has come and hang up.

For Number Display service subscribers

If you subscribe to Number Display service, the message heard by the caller will change according to the caller's situation.

Example:

If the caller requested not to send caller's information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean

"Your phone number is blocked by service provider. Please call again with adding '186' to the beginning of the phone number.".


When the following is displayed after pressing

通話拒否 (Block), you can set the unit to block the call from the same telephone number.

- To block the call, press はい (Yes). 迷惑設定しますか?
- To cancel blocking, press $\frac{\text{UND}}{\text{F4}}$ (No).
- When the following is displayed, press いいえ (No) to cancel.

Using the portable handset (KX-FKN515):



- Press while the unit is ringing or while you are on an incoming call.




